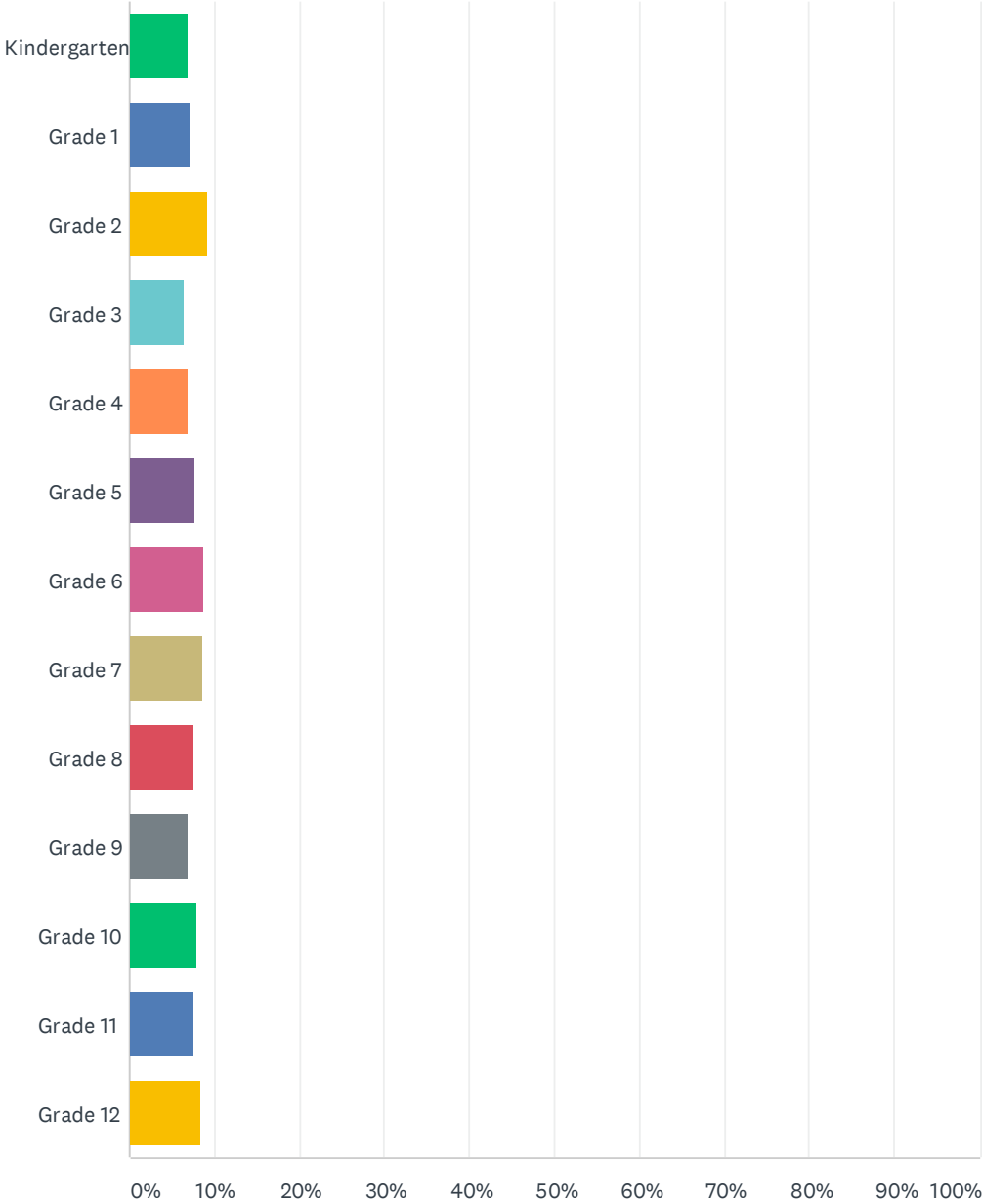


Q1 What grade will your child be entering in the Fall?

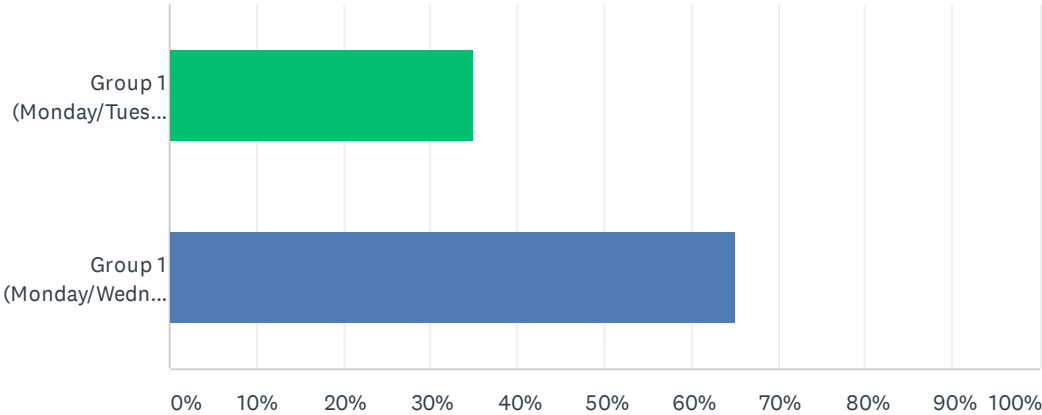

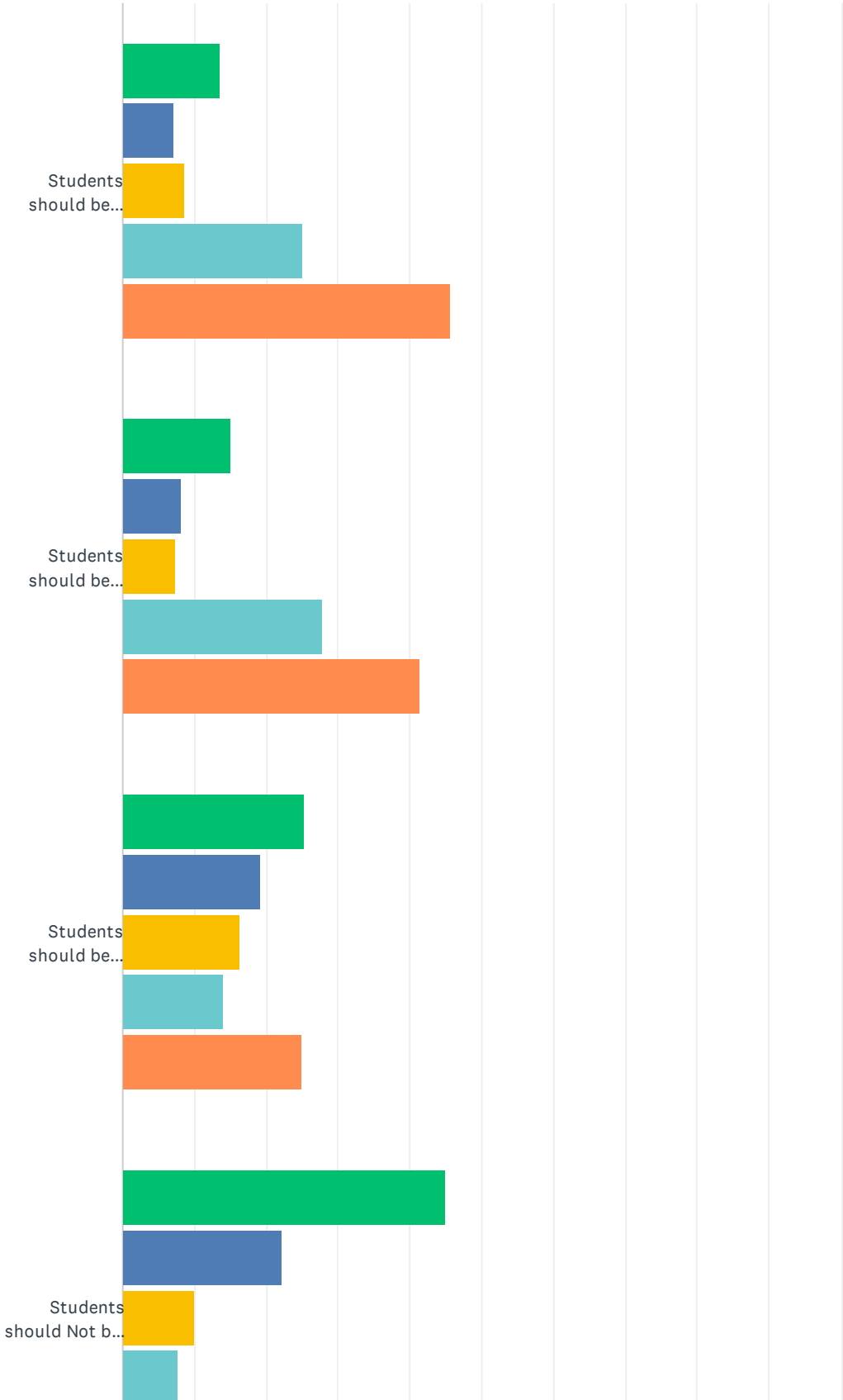

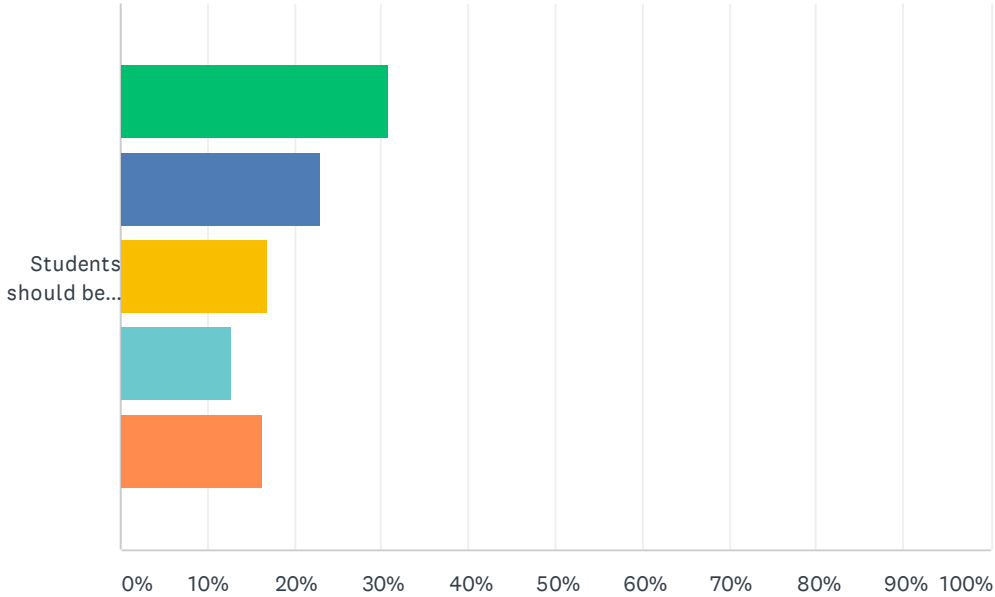

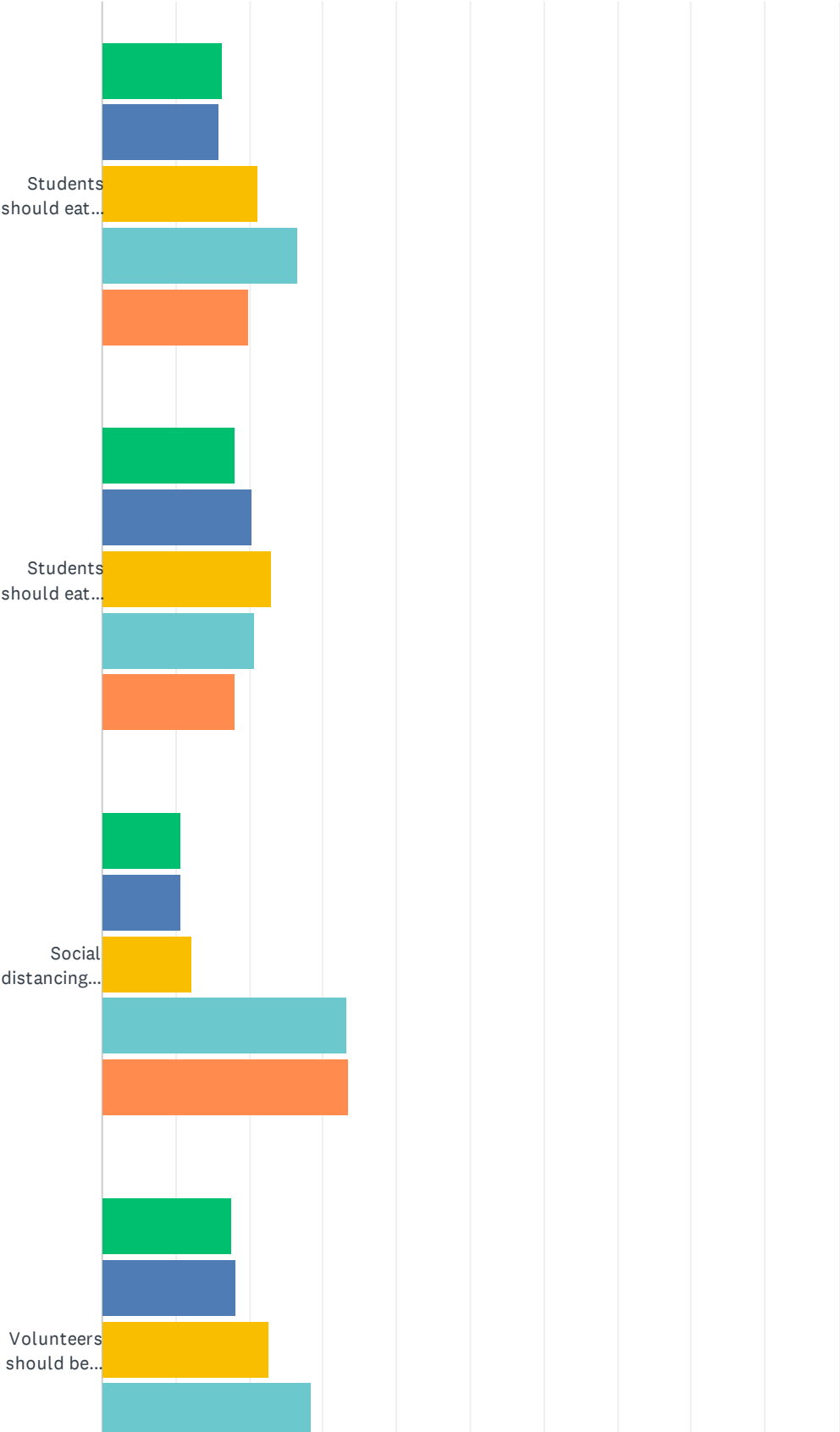

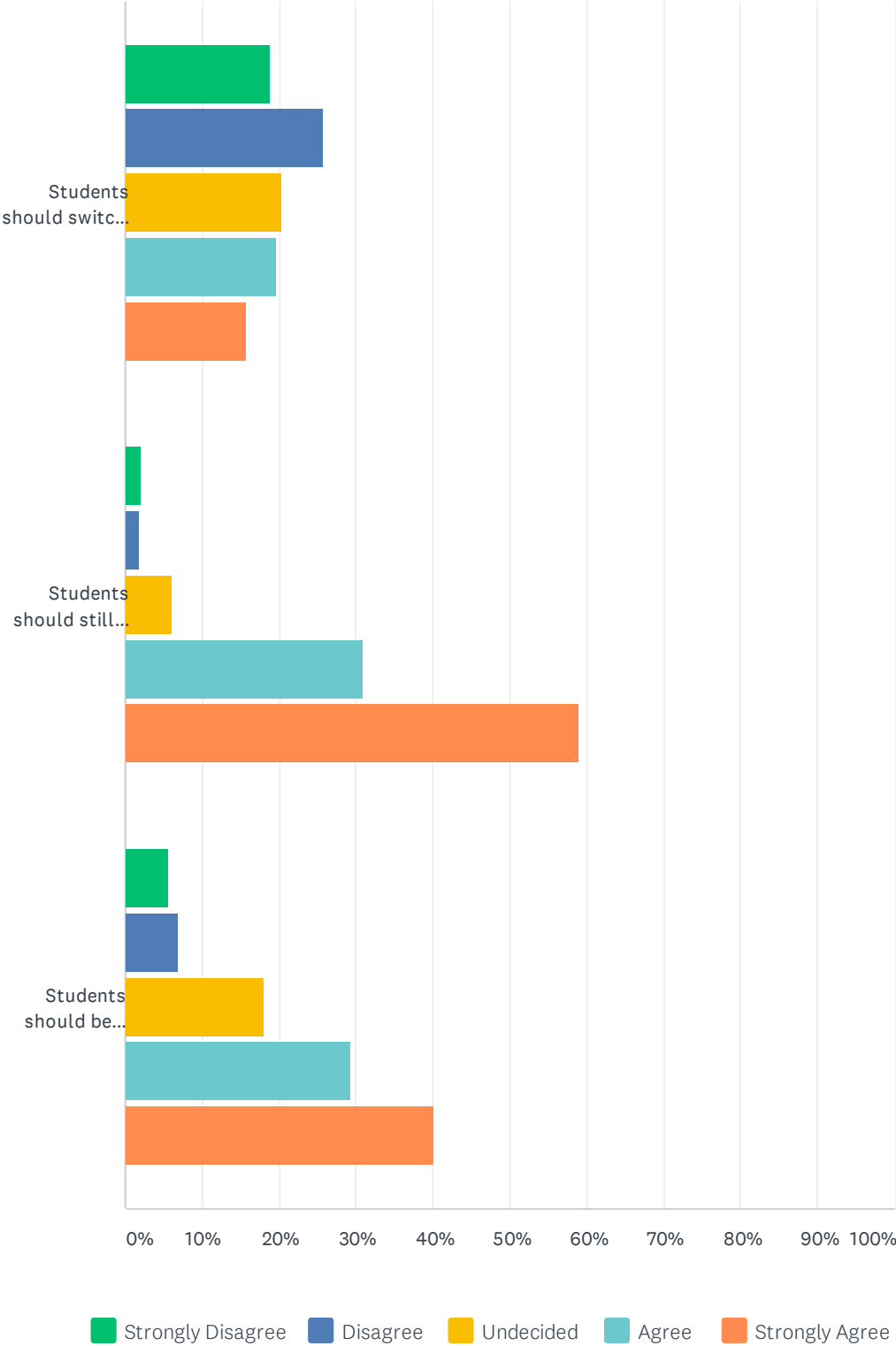

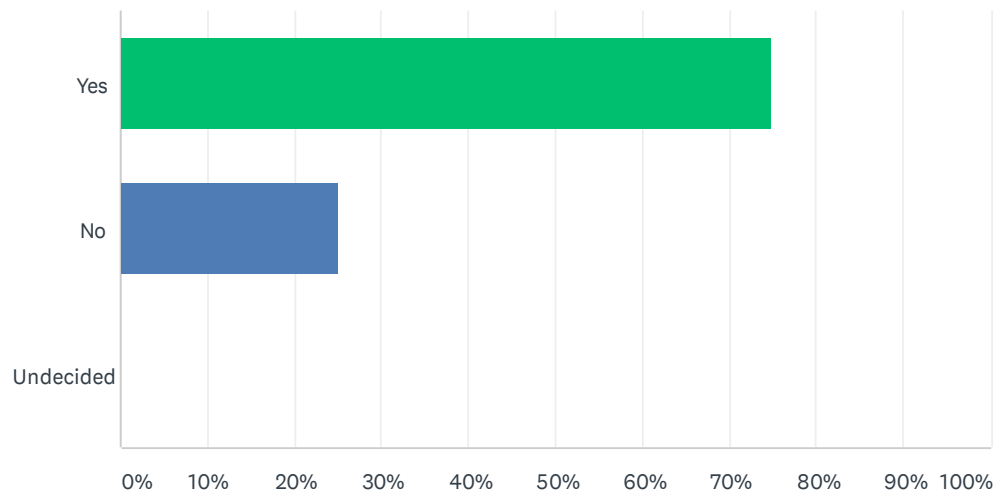

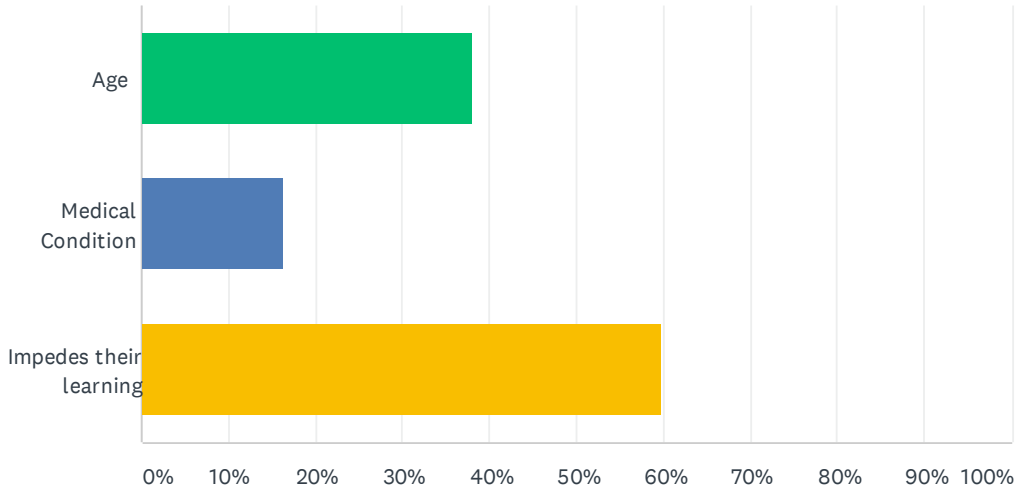

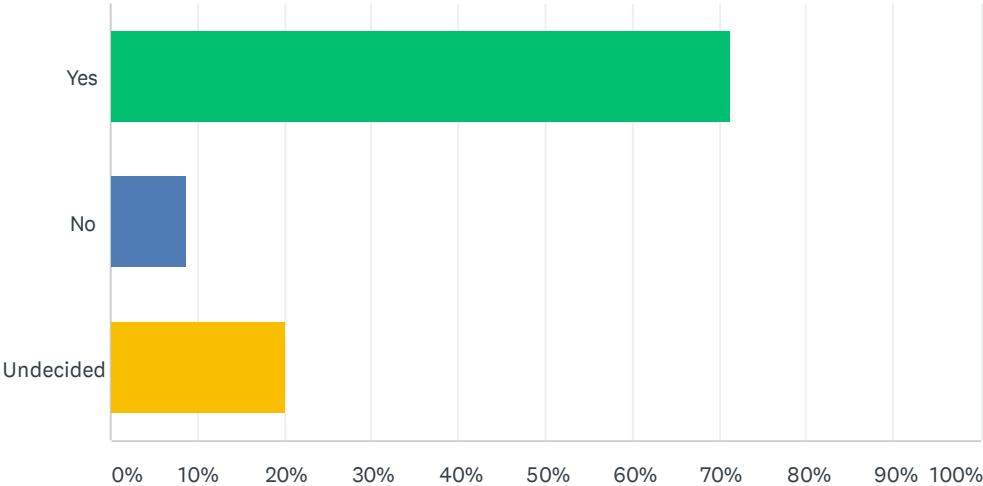
