All teachers will utilize Google Classroom.


Teachers will provide standards-based instruction.


Remote Learning:

Vildcat Folders Everyday, check the folder for graded



Supplies


In Pencil box:


 First graders are expected to master their sight words.


Science

Spelling

Spelling test will be given every week. The spelling words will focus on the phonics sounds that we are currently working on. The spelling words that are listed on the homework cover sheet can be used to practice.



Word Work

Sight words are words that all first graders are expected to know how to read by the end of the year. There are ten sight word lists. Each student is expected to pass at least one list per month. Students will be retested on all first grade sight words, even if they passed in kindergarten as many students forgot, memorized for a short time but did not master the list.
