Santiago AVID Scholarship Awards:

- Will be contingent on Santiago AVID budget.
- Can only be used for tuition, on-campus housing, books and/or fees at a two or four year college/university
- Are one-time-only award

Applicants Must:

- Plan to attend a two or four-year college or university
- Demonstrate *individual determination* and a commitment to higher education
- Be a Santiago AVID senior with a minimum of two years in our AVID program
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher and have completed (or be currently enrolled in) at least one Honors, AP or college level courses

Completed Applications Must Be Submitted in the Following Order:

1. Application Form
2. Transcript—**unofficial/no envelopes**; must include grades from first semester of senior year;
3. Essay
4. One letter of recommendation--open, no envelopes or have recommender email it to rpadilla@cnsud.k12.ca.us
