

Breakfast at Shull will be \$2.00 (7:30-8 a.m.) A cafeteria lunch will be \$2.75 per day. Parents can prepay for lunches on EZschoolpay.com. To access the system, you must know your student's permanent ID number (AR number). New students can get these numbers from their teachers. Kindergarten teachers will send home these codes the first month of school. You many call the office if you do not know this number. Milk is 50 cents for students bringing their lunches. Reduced price for lunch is 40 cents.
