## **Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results**

**Content Knowledge:** Students will be able to create a strong password and evaluate their password to ensure that it meets the standards to ensure their information stays private. Students will be able to organize their google drive and work collaboratively on a document that will allow us all to better know each other.

**Vocabulary:** Digital Citizenship, hacker, collaboration

**Skills:** Students will learn strategies for naming files, organizing them into folders, and collaborate on documents within Google.

- Demonstrate proper etiquette when working in a digital collaborative environment.
- Apply strategies in organizing digital files and resources.

**Expectation:** Students will have 2 "root" folders: Grade 3 and Grade 4; within the grade 4 folder they will have 4 subfolders: LA, Math, Science, and Social Studies. These folders will be color-coded. All documents will be saved within these folders, and all untitled documents will be either named or deleted.

Students will use a shared document to tell about me and each other about themselves. Students will take a class survey about their coding and computer background, and within that survey will reflect on at least one thing they learned about their classmates from their work on the group document.
