In order to help maintain the skills your child has worked so hard to progress on throughout the year, Brown School students are encouraged to read and jot in their readers' notebooks over the period that they are home. Grade four language arts teachers strongly suggest that students are reading for a minimum of 45 minutes each day and practicing strategies in their readers' notebook. Students are currently in a nonfiction unit; however students are encouraged to read narrative books as well. Students can visit the website <https://www.storylineonline.net/> to access free picture book read-alouds. We encourage you to spark conversations around the texts that your child is reading and around the online activities they choose to complete.

To maintain the math skills that your child has worked so hard to acquire, the grade four math teachers strongly suggest that students practice multiplication and division facts and access the collection of grade level specific resources on the MPS distance learning website. In addition, students can continue to practice the standard algorithm for addition and subtraction that they recently learned.

We hope the online offerings will give you additional resources to stay engaged in learning.
