<p>Wednesday: Continue Research/Begin Projects.</p> <p>Make sure each member is contributing. I am able to see who is typing on each doc and inputting pictures. Hold yourself accountable for doing your share.</p>		
<p>Thursday: Today is a live session day. We will talk about how to organize your presentation and share out some work that students have already started.</p> <p>You will be successful today if you begin working on your presentation and share it with me. You will have 2 days to complete your slideshow.</p>		
Friday: Today, your mission is to finalize your slideshow. You should use the Criteria for Success Checklist to help you accomplish your goal.
