Grade 5 Visual Arts *Surrealist Zentangle Portraits*

Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

Content Knowledge: Students will create a multi-media portrait

Vocabulary: Portraiture, line, pattern, texture, shape, composition

Skills: Drawing

Expectation: A completed portrait uploaded to Classroom

Description of Task (s):	Resources and Materials:	Daily Checks (Return to Google Classroom or snapshots from a cell phone)
Students will take a photo of themselves or choose a family member or a magazine cut out, and use it as the basis of a zen-tangle portrait. They will cut out just the face and glue it down to another sheet of paper, then design the hair and background using lines and shapes in the style of zentangle artwork.
