Grade 6 Band - Concert Repertoire

Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

To improve playing skills, learn concert music to make “performance perfect”

Content Knowledge: Music Notation, Performance

Vocabulary: Note and rest values, Note reading, dynamics, articulation

Skills: Performing concert music on a band instrument to sound “Performance Perfect” (use of correct notes, rhythms, dynamics, and articulation)

Expectation: Students should be able to maintain their usual practice schedule as well as continue to learn music theory.
