## Grade 6 Band - Concert Repertoire

### Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

To improve playing skills, learn concert music to make “performance perfect”

**Content Knowledge:** Music Notation, Performance

**Vocabulary:** Note and rest values, Note reading, dynamics, articulation

**Skills:** Performing concert music on a band instrument to sound “Performance Perfect” (use of correct notes, rhythms, dynamics, and articulation)

**Expectation:** Students should be able to maintain their usual practice schedule as well as continue to learn music theory.

Description of Task (s):	Resources and Materials:	Daily Checks (Return to Google Classroom or snapshots from a cell phone)
Monday: Students will go to <a href="http://jwpepper.com">jwpepper.com</a> and listen to one of the concert pieces - The first concert piece is, “Of Castles and Kings”. As they listen, they will write down specific things in the music that they can work on to improve their individual playing. When finished, students can practice the specific tasks they listed.
