Grade 7 Orchestra - Strings

Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Students continue to build their skills on their chosen instrument as well as their appreciation for music.

Content Knowledge: Note Reading, Rhythm Reading, Steady Tempo, Key Signature, Time Signature, Shifting, Multiple Endings, Articulations (staccato, slurs, accents, etc)

Skills: Practice concert repertoire for fluency, utilizing the content/concepts from the method book and concert repertoire.

Expectation: Students should be able to maintain their usual practice schedule as well as continue to learn music theory.

<p>Monday - Wednesday: Concert Repertoire:</p> <p>Students will work on a segment of one concert piece following the practice techniques in the video. Throughout the week they will work on specific segments until they have completed the entire piece.</p> <p>Students will work through "Symphony No.40". Students will review the key signature and the finger pattern that is associated with it.
