Grade 7 Visual Arts Elective - Weaving

Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results:Students will create two God’s Eyes or one double God’s Eye

Content Knowledge: Weaving, Patterns, Colors Schemes

Vocabulary: Spokes

Skills: Weaving

Expectation: Students will construct a basic God’s Eye from two sticks and will weave around the sticks’ “spokes” with yarns, strings, ribbon or any raw, natural, pliable material found in nature. Students should create at least two God’s Eyes. For more of a challenge, students may weave two God’s Eyes together. (Directions below)

Description of Task (s):	Resources and Materials:	Daily Checks (Return to Google Classroom or snapshots from a cell phone)
Day 1: Plan your God’s Eye and gather your materials.	YouTube video: How to Make a God's Eye Sophie's World	Take a pic of you materials
Day 2: Construct your first basic God’s Eye: Attach two sticks together by holding the two sticks together in the middle forming a cross with your thumb and index finger. Then wrap yarn, string, or ribbon, etc. around the sticks in the middle a few times to secure the sticks in place. Turn and wrap on the opposite diagonal. (You may also hot glue the sticks together, or use twisties.) Refer to the youtube video.	YouTube video: How to Make a God's Eye Sophie's World	Attach your sticks

Description of Task (s):	Resources and Materials:	Daily Checks (Return to Google Classroom or snapshots from a cell phone)
<p>Day 3: Start weaving your first God's Eye. Starting in the middle of the cross, hold your sticks in place with your thumb and index finger with one hand and with the other hand with your yarn, weave over and around each stick spoke. Keep rotating your God's Eye in the same direction (a quarter turn) and weave over and around each of the four spokes.</p> <p>Challenge: Start with 2 God's Eyes' and attach them creating 8 spokes rather than four for the basic God's Eye..</p>		Begin weaving.
<p>Day 4: :Continue weaving until you reach the outer edge of your sticks. As you weave, consider colors, textures, and patterns When you want to change colors, cut your yarn and tie another color onto the previous yarn.</p>		Begin weaving your second God's Eye, or attaching two God's Eyes to create one God's eye with 8 rather than 4 spokes.
<p>Day 5: Finish your God's Eyes by tucking in your yarns, and then trimming the yarn's tail.</p> <p>Take a photo of your God's Eyes and submit in Google Classroom by going to Classwork, then scroll down to Assignment.</p>		Finish by trimming. Then take a pic and submit on Google Classroom.

Week criteria for success (attach student checklists or rubrics): Gather materials. construct crosses for two basic God's Eyes, Weave God's Eyes, Trim God's Eyes, Take pics of God's Eyes and submit to Google Classroom.
