

## Grade 8 Band - Concert Repertoire

**Targeted Goals from Stage 1:** To improve playing skills, learn concert music to make “performance perfect”

**Content Knowledge:** Music Notation, Performance

**Vocabulary:** Note and rest values, Note reading, dynamics, articulation

**Skills:** Performing concert music and book selections on a band instrument to sound “Performance Perfect” (use of correct notes, rhythms, dynamics, and articulation)

**Expectation:** Students should be able to maintain their usual practice schedule as well as continue to learn music theory.
