## Visual Arts Grade 8 ART - Drawing - Georgia O'Keeffe

## Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Observational Drawing

Content Knowledge: Realistic drawing, color theory

Vocabulary: Medium, contour lines, color shading, abstraction

Skills: Observational drawing, Color layering to create third colors

**Expectation:** Students will watch the video on Georgia O'Keeffe which highlights her life, inspiration and work. Students will then draw a single flower head/blossom in the artistic style of O'Keeffe from a <u>bird's eye view</u> the scale of which should be no smaller than 8" x 10". The flower should extend to the edges of the paper providing little to no background. Students should include the outer edges as well as the inner edges of the flower. (Contour Drawing). Students will then apply color with a medium of their choice such as watercolors, colored pencils, markers, oil pastels, etc. as they layer colors to represent the subtle color changes within the flower.

Day 4: Students will begin to add color and will include subtle color changes by layering colors.		
Friday: Students will finish their Georgia O'Keeffe drawing or painting (depending on their medium) and will take a pic and will submit to Google Classroom.		Due: Friday, May 29th
