## Grade K Social Studies - Modified from Unit 3 - Me and My School Community

## **Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results**

Students will identify community helpers and their role in helping the community

Content Knowledge: Important members of the school community and their roles and responsibilities

**Vocabulary:** citizen, citizenship, kindness, traits, attributes, roles, responsibility, leader, hero, role model, honor, award.

Skills: Explaining how all people, not just official leaders, play an important role in helping and improving the community over time

**Expectation:** Students will identify community members and celebrate one of their heroes
