QUESTIONS TO ASK PROSPECTIVE COLLEGES

During tours, interviews, visits, college fairs, ect.

Academics

- What is the average class size?
- What are the smallest class sizes? The largest?
- Can you cross-register at any other nearby colleges/universities?
- Are there any required courses?
- What type of academic advising is provided?
- Do you give credit for AP courses? Is a certain test score required?

Location/Student Life

- How large is the campus?
- Does the college provide transportation locally?
- Is housing guaranteed for all 4 years?
- What kinds of off-campus housing are available nearby?
- What services are provided in the dorms i.e. laundry, kitchen, air conditioning?
- Are freshman required to live on campus? In separate dorms?
- Do you have your own food service or an outside caterer?
- What meal plans are available? How many meals each day?
- What athletic teams do you have? Division? Can I meet one of the coaches?
- Can students have cars on campus? Freshman? Parking fees?

Financial Aid

- Will applying for financial aid have an impact on the admission decision?
- Is financial aid based on need? On merit?
- Do you offer scholarships? What type are available? How do I apply?
- Do you offer work-study jobs? How do I apply for those? Is there off-campus employment available? Where are jobs posted?
- What are the financial aid procedures and deadlines? Which forms?
- When are financial aid packages awarded?

Admission

- What information do you receive from applicants? SAT/ACT/SAT II? An Interview? How many recommendations?
- What are your academic requirements?
- Do you have an application deadline? When? Or do you operate on a rolling admission basis? When are most applications received?
- How much does it cost to apply?

Career Resources / Alumni

- Do you offer internships? Are they required? Are they paid positions or for class credit? Are they available for all majors?
- What career services do you offer?
