Grade 6 Health: Effective Communication

Targeted Goals from Stage 1: Desired Results

Content Knowledge: Communication styles can be aggressive, passive, assertive, or passive-aggressive. Assertiveness is the most effective type of communication because it is respectful and communicates what you need. Using “I statements” allows one to communicate how they feel rather than blame another person. This creates an opportunity for understanding and for a less defensive response.
