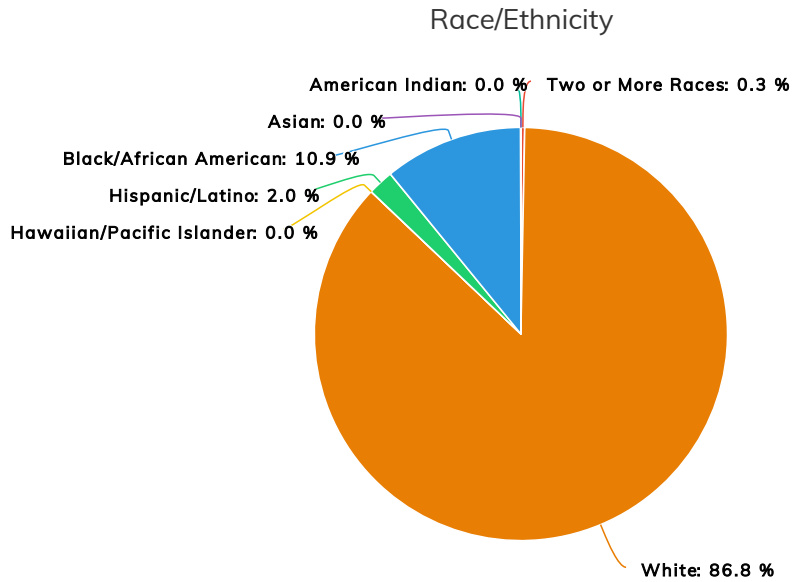

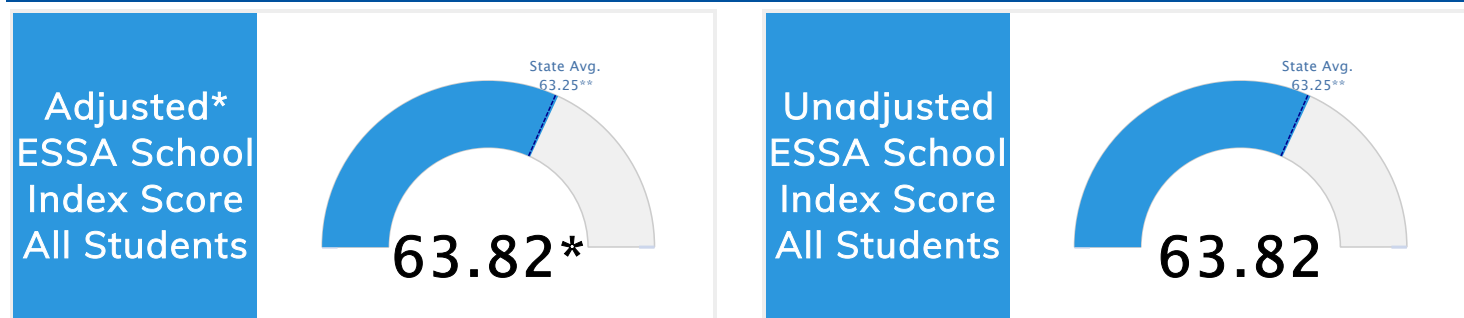

School Performance • ESSA School Index Score 2021



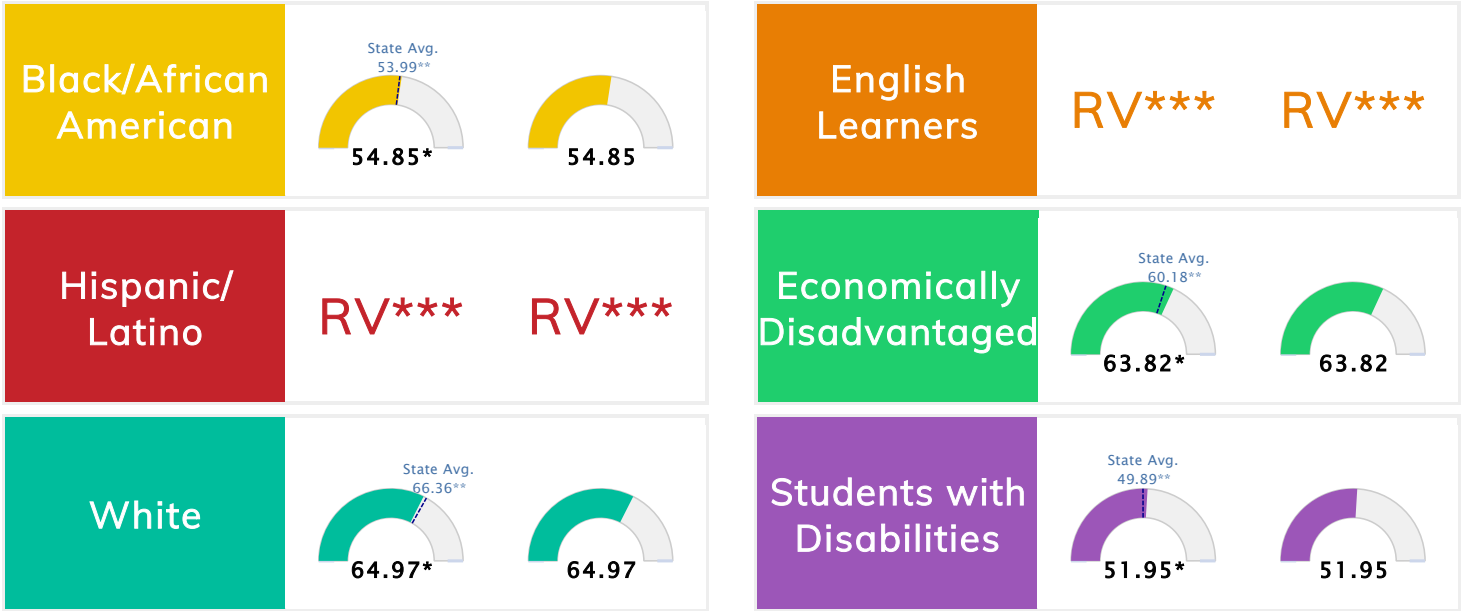
