Our class and will use PAWS to explain and reinforce expected behavior. Students can earn PAWS in the classroom, hallways, library, lunch benches, recess, etc. They will be given PAWS with our schools app. The app tracks how many PAWS students have earned and spent through the year. PAWS can be redeemed at various times through the year.

When a problem arises students will be reminded of the expectations and retaught appropriate behavior. If the problem continues, a Think Slip will go home that needs to be signed by parents and sent back.



Homework


