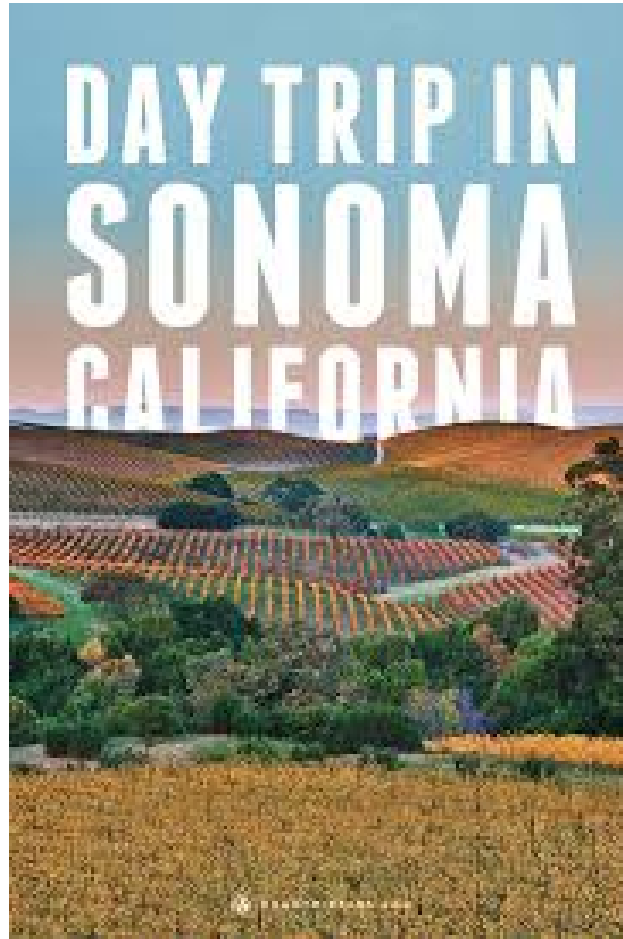

Society of Academic Skeletal Radiologists

OBJECTIVES and GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR MEMBERSHIP

The objectives of the Society are to provide an informal setting where in American academic musculoskeletal radiologists can come together and discuss all aspects of the field of musculoskeletal radiology in order to further understand the musculoskeletal system, including its disease processes and their imaging appearances. The society seeks to enhance patient care, teaching and research.

To meet the objectives, the Society will strive to;

1. Be a collegial society dedicated to promoting education and research directed to innovative patient care.
2. Foster the continuing development of the clinical specialty of musculoskeletal imaging as an art and a science.
3. Have an annual meeting for presentations and dissemination of knowledge
4. Maintain a web site and Internet presence
5. Maintain an online "core knowledge" library of the most recent articles and clinical cases that musculoskeletal fellows and musculoskeletal radiologists should be familiar with
6. Promote order in the fellowship recruitment process

Membership in the Society shall be restricted to American academic musculoskeletal radiologists employed in a university setting in the United States, who are engaged in the active general practice of musculoskeletal radiology, including conventional radiography, CT, MR imaging and ultrasound, as well as arthrography and interventional procedures. Each member must devote at least 75% of his/her clinical practice to musculoskeletal radiology. A candidate for membership must be invited to join the Society by a member in good standing. The candidate's academic chairperson must provide a letter to the Membership Subcommittee explicitly stating that the candidate meets the membership requirements.
