



Student Assessment History Report User Guide

DIVISION OF ACADEMIC STANDARDS, INSTRUCTION AND ASSESSMENT

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Reports and data on the Secure Reports section of the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) website are provided by multiple divisions at MDE. This user guide will provide information on the Student Assessment History Report, available under Assessment Secure Reports. Contact mde.testing@state.mn.us for questions regarding the report and system functionality.

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Purpose of the Student Assessment History Report

The purpose of the Student Assessment History Report is to allow districts to access test history for students who are newly enrolled to their district, based on Minnesota Automated Reporting Student System (MARSS) enrollment information submitted to MDE.

Accessing the Student Assessment History Report

The process for gaining access to MDE secure systems is available on the [Data Submissions page](#) (MDE website > Districts Schools and Educators > Business and Finance > Data Submissions). Additional information for District Assessment Coordinators (DACs) is also available in the [New District Assessment Coordinators: Getting Access](#) document (MDE website > Districts, Schools and Educators > Teaching and Learning > Statewide Testing > District Resources). Each district's Identified Official with Authority (IOWA) manages user access to MDE secure systems. Use the [MDE Organization Reference Glossary \(MDE-ORG\)](#) to look up the IOWA for a specific district (MDE website > About > Schools and Organizations (MDE-ORG)).

Overview of the Student Assessment History Report

The Student Assessment History Report provides districts access to test history for newly enrolled students, based on MARSS enrollment information submitted to MDE. Only district-level users in Assessment Secure Reports have access to the Student Assessment History Report. School-level users will receive a message indicating that they do not have access to the report.

The student assessment history report includes the following assessments that can be matched to the student; refer to Appendix A for additional information about the assessments that may appear:

- Standards-based accountability assessments (Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments (MCA)/Minnesota Test of Academic Skills (MTAS), as well as historical assessments like MCA-Modified and Mathematics Test for English Language Learners (MTELL)).
- English language proficiency accountability assessments (ACCESS/Alternate ACCESS for English Language Learners (ELLs), as well as historical assessments like Test of Emerging Academic English (TEAE)/ Minnesota Student Oral Language Observation Matrix (MN SOLOM)).
- Graduation Required Records (GRR) and Reimbursement entries (entries made in GRR for college entrance exam reimbursement).
- Historical graduation-related assessments (statewide administrations of Career and College Assessments in 2014–15, Graduation-Required Assessments for Diploma (GRAD)).

The look up of student scores is done by the MARSS number and results include historical assessment records validated through the Student Identity System.

Updating of the Student Assessment History Report Each Fall

In the fall of each year, there is a short period of time when testing history will not be available in the Student Assessment History Report until districts submit MARSS enrollment data for the new school year.

The submission of MARSS data is required to verify that the district may have access to student information. The assessment history will be again available after MARSS is submitted by the district.

New students submitted in MARSS should appear immediately after submission in the Student Assessment History Report, if any testing history is available. When changes are made to an enrolled student's identity (such as name, birthdate, or State Student Identification (SSID) number), any linked assessment data may not appear in (or be removed from) the report until the following week as additional validations need to be run at MDE.

Similarly, when current assessment results are published at MDE (such as the District Student Results/ School Student Results (DSR/SSR) files), those assessments may not appear in the report until the following day. However, until enrollment information is submitted for the following school year, districts only have access to students who were enrolled in the previous school year.

Accessing Student Assessment History Reports

Student testing history can be looked up on an individual basis or for multiple students at one time.

Search at the Individual Student Level

To search for the testing history for one student, enter the MARSS/SSID number and select “Run Report.”

Search for Multiple Students at One Time

To search for testing history for multiple students at one time, enter the MARSS/SSID numbers one per line as shown below. This can be done by copy/paste from Excel or other extract. Make sure there are no commas, semi-colons or other text between numbers.

If test results are available, they will appear below. The following screenshot provides an example. To look for testing history for a different student, delete the MARSS/SSID numbers in the field, enter new ones, and select “Run Report.”

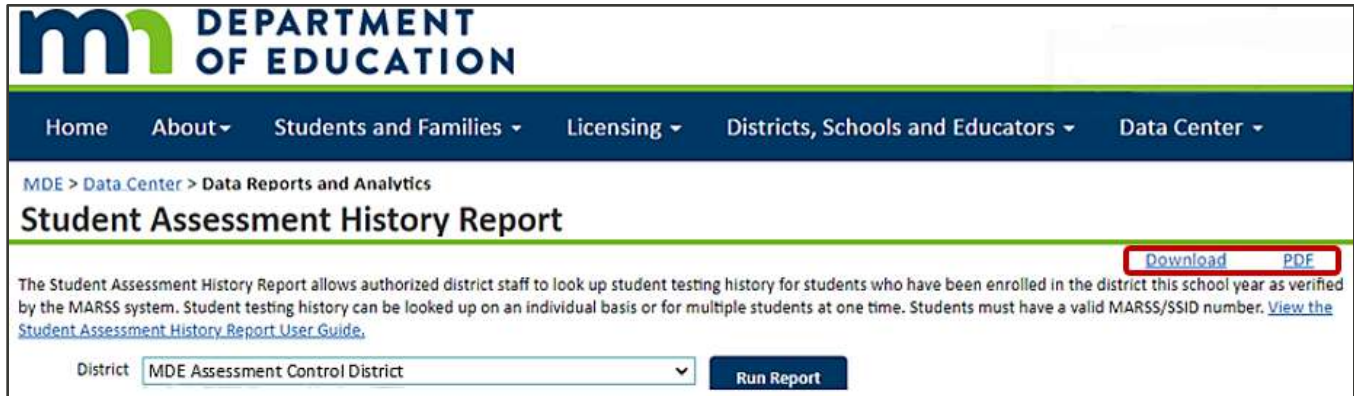

Enrollment Data Source	Date of last MARSS Data Submission File (End of Year = E or Fall= F).
MARSS/SSID	Student MARSS/SSID number.
Student Name	Student name from the enrollment record. Format is last name, first name, and middle name.
Birth Date	Birth date from the enrollment record.
Gender	Gender from the enrollment record.
Enrolled Fiscal Year	Year of enrollment from the enrollment record.
District Number/Type	Currently enrolled District Number/Type.
Grd	Grade test taken for test record; appears blank for GRR entries.
Test Date	Date test was taken; for GRR entries, this date is test date entered; for Reimbursements, the date of reimbursement is indicated.
Test Name	Test name and applicable series number; “GRR” is indicated for GRR entries; “Reimbursed” is indicated for college entrance exams that have been reimbursed by MDE; refer to Appendix A for additional information on test names. Note: In order for a GRR entry to have been reimbursed, there must be two GRR entries shown – one with “GRR” and the tested date and one with “Reimbursed” and the date of reimbursement. If only the “GRR” entry appears, that record was not reimbursed by MDE.

Downloading Student Assessment History Report Files

Each of the Assessment Secure Reports pages has download options on the page or in the upper right corner of the screen.

For the Student Assessment History Report, selecting the “Download” button automatically opens the file in Excel. The same information on the screen appears in the Excel download with one exception; the test Unique Identification Number (UIN) is included in the download only. The UIN is intended for internal MDE use to quickly find and retrieve a unique test record when circumstances require it.

The Student Assessment History Report also has the option to view PDFs. When a user selects PDF in the upper right of the screen, the information displayed below on the screen will open in a PDF format that may either be saved or printed. Note: If testing history for multiple students was accessed, each student’s testing history appears on a separate page.
