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**Tracy Historical Museum/West Side Pioneer Association Program Description**

**Museum Scholarships and Judith Ann Lee Memorial Scholarship**

**Museum Scholarships – Two (2) \$500 Awards:** Graduating students/seniors planning to attend a 2-year or 4-year college, or a vocational trade school with a demonstrated interest in local Tracy History

**Judith Ann Lee Memorial Scholarship – One (1) \$500 Award:** Graduating student/senior planning to attend a 2-year or 4-year college, or a vocational trade school with a demonstrated interest in local Tracy History

**Application Deadline:** March 31, 2022

**a. General Purpose of Scholarships –**

To recognize Tracy area graduating high school students/seniors who have demonstrated an interest or involvement with the history of the Tracy community.

**b. Eligibility Requirements**

1. Senior (or high school student on accelerated schedule) eligible to graduate with a high school diploma in May/June of current school year;
2. Enrolled in a public high school located within Tracy Unified School District (TUSD) High School boundaries
3. Lives within the TUSD High School District boundaries;
4. Plans to attend accredited 2-year, 4-year college, or a vocational trade school as a full-time student in Fall following graduation;
5. Demonstrated interest in Local Tracy History.

**c. Application Process - Submission Deadline - March 31, 2022**

1. Submit complete hard copy of application for with Local History volunteer statement, or paper/essay, or project by deadline;
2. Email copy of volunteer statement, or paper/essay, or project summary by deadline;

**d. Award Selection Factors**

1. Extent of demonstrated interest in local history;
2. Uniqueness and originality of the history documented;
3. Quality of the presentation.

Papers/essays/projects will be placed in the Museum archives and portions may be reprinted in the Museum Newsletter.

**e. Scholarship Award Distribution Guidelines and Conditions of Award**

All applicants will be notified in writing of the determinations by the end of the school year. It is the target to announce award recipients before high school Awards Night ceremonies.

  - I completed a Local History paper or project in school.
  - I wrote an essay on a Local Tracy History topic as a special activity.
2. If you volunteered with the Tracy Historical Museum or other local history group, list your volunteer experience below and attach a Volunteer Statement describing the place, type and amount of volunteer service, historical relevance, and your reflection on the experience.
3. If you completed a Local Tracy History paper or project in school, or you wrote a Local Tracy History essay as a special activity, state the title of your paper/essay or project below and submit the paper/essay or project.

**IV. VOLUNTEER STATEMENT, PAPER/ESSAY, OR PROJECT REQUIREMENTS**

1. Volunteer statements should be 1-2 pages, typed, double spaced, and include your name, statement title, date, page numbers and description of volunteer experience (organization, type of service, hours/days volunteered, volunteer work completed, reflection on historical relevance and experience).
2. Papers/essays should be at least 2 pages (no maximum page limit), typed, double spaced, and include your name, paper/essay title, and date on the first page or title page; identifying footer and page numbers; and Works Cited or References.
3. If submitting a project, please submit with the application form, or arrange delivery to the Museum or other method of review as applicable, by the application deadline. Projects should be labeled with you name, project title, and date and include a 1-2 page project summary. The project summary should be typed, double spaced, and include your name, project title, date, page numbers and description of the project and its relevance to Local Tracy History. Projects will be returned after review *if requested*.
4. Also email copy of your volunteer statement, paper/essay, or project summary to the Tracy Historical Museum in WORD format to [tracymuseum@sbcglobal.net](mailto:tracymuseum@sbcglobal.net) and [tagsca@sbcglobal.net](mailto:tagsca@sbcglobal.net) by application deadline.
