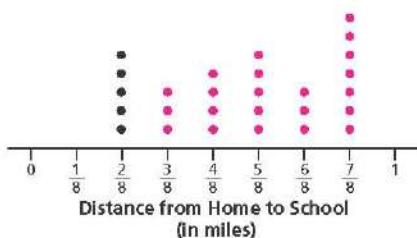


## Homework

$\frac{3}{8}$	3
$\frac{4}{8}$	4

$\frac{6}{8}$	3
$\frac{7}{8}$	7
