ACT TEST DATES:

April 13th - REGISTER BY March 8th

Greenwood High School will host ACT Prep classes. To register you need to go to <u>http://www.greenwoodk12.com</u>, the cost is \$50. The classes are Monday-Thursdays from 4-7. The next class dates are April 1-11th. For more information, you can pick a flyer up in the office.

Scholarships:

February 14th is the final scholarship deadline at UCA. Also, if you have received word that you still need to turn in any documents, you must submit all needed information by the February 14th deadline.

February 15th is the final ATU-Russellville scholarship deadline, including the private scholarships.
