## ACT TEST DATES:

**April 13<sup>th</sup> - REGISTER BY March 8th**

**Greenwood High School will host ACT Prep classes. To register you need to go to <http://www.greenwoodk12.com>, the cost is \$50. The classes are Monday-Thursdays from 4-7. The next class dates are April 1-11th. For more information, you can pick a flyer up in the office.**

Juniors will be taking the ACT test on Wednesday, February 20<sup>th</sup> 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> hours in Mrs. Vaughan's, Mrs. Rachuy's and Mr. Brown's rooms. Juniors will report to the cafeteria for breakfast.

Juniors and Seniors – The ATU-Ozark recruiter will be here on Friday, February 15<sup>th</sup> during 2<sup>nd</sup> hour in the conference room to meet with you and answer any questions you may have regarding ATU-Ozark.

Sophomores – Balfour will be here Friday, February 15<sup>th</sup> to do a ring presentation. They will be coming back Friday, March 4<sup>th</sup> to take any orders.

If you are a 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grader planning on taking Concurrent credit/Distance learning classes through ATU/Virtual Arkansas for the 2019-2020 school year you need to come to the office and sign up. Make

sure you pick up paperwork if you are signing up for Concurrent Credit classes. Deadline to be signed up and to have your paperwork turned in is March 1<sup>st</sup>.
