Scholarships:

You can now pick up information for the Shelter Insurance Foundation Scholarship. The deadline to apply is March 31st.

The Conway Regional Health Foundation Scholarship Application is now available online at

https://app.mykaleidoscope.com/scholarship/ConwayRegionalHealth

Applicants must be studying one of the following on a full-time basis: medicine, nursing, laboratory/research, radiology, physical therapy, speech therapy, surgical technology, dentistry, occupational therapy, respiratory therapy, pharmacy, medical information, or another health related field. Applicants must also be residents of Arkansas or attending college in Arkansas.

If you have a documented learning disability and will be enrolled in the Fall Semester at a university, two-year community college, or a vocational/technical training program, please see Mrs. Rachuy about the Ralph G. Norman Scholarship.

Any Senior who plans to attend a college/university, vocational-technical or trade school is eligible to apply for the AACTEA Scholarship and the ASPMA Scholarship. Pick up applications in Mrs. Rachuy's office. The AACTEA Scholarship is due by April 1st, and the ASPMA Scholarship is due by April 9th

Any Senior girl who plans to pursue a teaching degree should apply for the Francis Carol Criss Ramsy Scholarship. See Mrs. Rachuy for an application. Applications are due April 10th.

John and Lee Ella McDonald Scholarship applications are available in the counselor's office. Applications must be postmarked by March 26, 2021.

Applications for the 2021 Danielle Emery Agency \$500 Scholarship are available in the office for students whose parents have insurance through Allstate. Applications are due by March 31st.
