Scholarships:

UAFS Prestigious Scholarship deadline is November 15th and has a separate online application.

UofA Fayetteville Priority Scholarship deadline is November 15th and the admissions priority deadline is November 1st.

ATU-Russ Priority Scholarship deadline is November 15th.

ATU Foundation/Private/Alumni Scholarship deadline is also November 15th. Apply at arkansastech.awardspring.com

UCA Priority Scholarship deadline is December 10th, October is the last ACT score UCA will consider for scholarships.

The UAFS 2020 Prestigious Scholarship application is now available online @ <https://admissions.uaufs.edu/financial-aid/prestigious>. Students must be fully admitted to the university in order to apply for Prestigious Scholarships. On a student's acceptance letter they are provided their Student ID number. This number is required for successful submission of the application. Deadline to apply is November 15, 2019.

UAFS Lion's Share is where seniors need to go to access and apply for UAFS Foundation Scholarships. More information about Lion's Share can be found at: <https://admissions.uaufs.edu/lionsshare> - This online application is open Nov. 1st-Dec 1st 2019.

All UAFS scholarships require students to be college level on their ACT. College level requires students to have obtained at least a 19 in all subsections along with their composite score.

UAFS does not superscore ACT exams.

Arkansas State in Jonesboro is now offering students who have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of zero on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) no upfront cost to attend ASU next year. If you have a zero EFC, you have zero tuition and fee costs to attend A-State.

Seniors, if your ACT score improved on this last ACT you will need to let the office know what colleges to send your updated scores to.

Seniors don't forget to be working on your resume and asking for letters of recommendation. Give a two-week minimum notice when asking for letters.

Remember if you do not have qualifying ACT scores you will need to take the Accuplacer test.

ATU-Ozark's Preview Day is Tuesday, November 19th.

ATU- RUSS preview day Time Out for Tech is on February 6th.

UCA's Bear Facts Day is a senior preview day is on Friday December 6th.

If you are a senior interested in the military and need to retake the ASVAB, you can retake it on Monday, November 4th, 1st-4th hours.

If you are planning to earn a teaching degree, you need to check with the college you are going to attend because you are probably going to have to take the writing section of the ACT.
