FAFSA

October 1, 2019 is the 1st day students can complete the 2020-21 FAFSA. Students will use family's 2018 tax returns.

FSAID

Student and guardian will each need to get a FSAID at fsaid.ed.gov

After October 1st- Students can apply for the AR Challenge "Lottery" Scholarship at scholarship.adhe.edu

SELECTIVE SERVICES

Registration is required for all males 18 and over.

Scholarships:

UCA Priority Scholarship deadline is December 10th, October is the last ACT score UCA will consider for scholarships.

UAFS Lion's Share is where seniors need to go to access and apply for UAFS Foundation Scholarships. More information about Lion's Share can be found at:

<https://admissions.uafs.edu/lionsshare> - This online application is open Nov. 1st-Dec 1st 2019.

All UAFS scholarships require students to be college level on their ACT. College level requires students to have obtained at least a 19 in all subsections along with their composite score.

UAFS does not superscore ACT exams.

Arkansas State in Jonesboro is now offering students who have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of zero on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) no upfront cost to attend ASU next year. If you have a zero EFC, you have zero tuition and fee costs to attend A-State.

ATU, Foundation Scholarship deadline has been extended to December 15th. Some of your students may not have been admitted and received their ATU login information in time to apply for the original deadline, so they've extended the deadline!

COLLEGE VISITS

Make sure you pre-arrange All college visits with your Teachers 3 days in advance. And bring back your college Visit form to the office.

SENIOR EVENTS AND INFORMATION:

If you are a senior who was absent the day Mrs. Wisdom was in Mrs. Rachuy's room helping seniors complete their Youniversal applications for the Lottery or Governor's Distinguished Scholarships or the AR Future Grant, see Mrs. Wisdom ASAP. Also, see her if you were absent and didn't get the FAFSA information.

Seniors, if your ACT score improved on this last ACT you will need to let the office know what colleges to send your updated scores to.

Seniors don't forget to be working on your resume and asking for letters of recommendation. Give a two-week minimum notice when asking for letters.

Remember if you do not have qualifying ACT scores you will need to take the Accuplacer test.

If you are planning to earn a teaching degree, you need to check with the college you are going to attend because you are probably going to have to take the writing section of the ACT.
