**Scholarships:**

All UAFS scholarships require students to be college level on their ACT. College level requires students to have obtained at least a 19 in all subsections along with their composite score. UAFS does not superscore ACT exams.

**ATU, Foundation Scholarship deadline has been extended to December 15th. Some of your students may not have been admitted and received their ATU login information in time to apply for the original deadline, so they've extended the deadline!**

**SENIOR EVENTS AND INFORMATION:**

**Seniors, if your ACT score improved on this last ACT you will need to let the office know what colleges to send your updated scores to.**

**Seniors don't forget to be working on your resume and asking for letters of recommendation. Give a two-week minimum notice when asking for letters.**

**Remember if you do not have qualifying ACT scores you will need to take the Accuplacer test.**

**If you are planning to earn a teaching degree, you need to check with the college you are going to attend because you are probably going to have to take the writing section of the ACT.**
