Scholarships:

Seniors who wish to apply for the Visionary Scholarship Program should apply at www.AmericanCollegeFoundation.org by June 1st. Awards range from \$1000 to \$2500.

Students who have been offered an ATU Academic 4 (4.0+ grade point average) or ATU Academic 3 (3.75-3.99 GPA) may accept their scholarship offer from Arkansas Tech until **5 p.m. Friday, April 14**. Students can accept their scholarship through the link they received in their offer email or the QR code in their offer letter. Students who accept an ATU Academic 4 or ATU Academic 3 scholarship offer must schedule and confirm an academic advising appointment by **5 p.m. Friday, May 5**. Students who do not fulfill these requirements are at risk of LOSING their scholarship.
