- AP World History

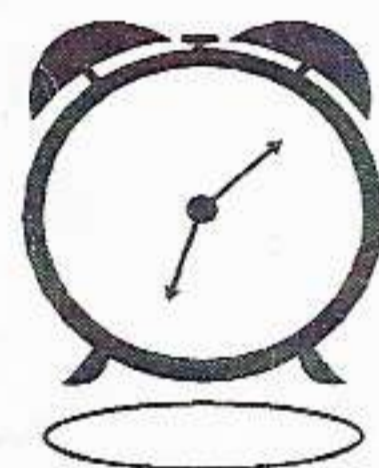

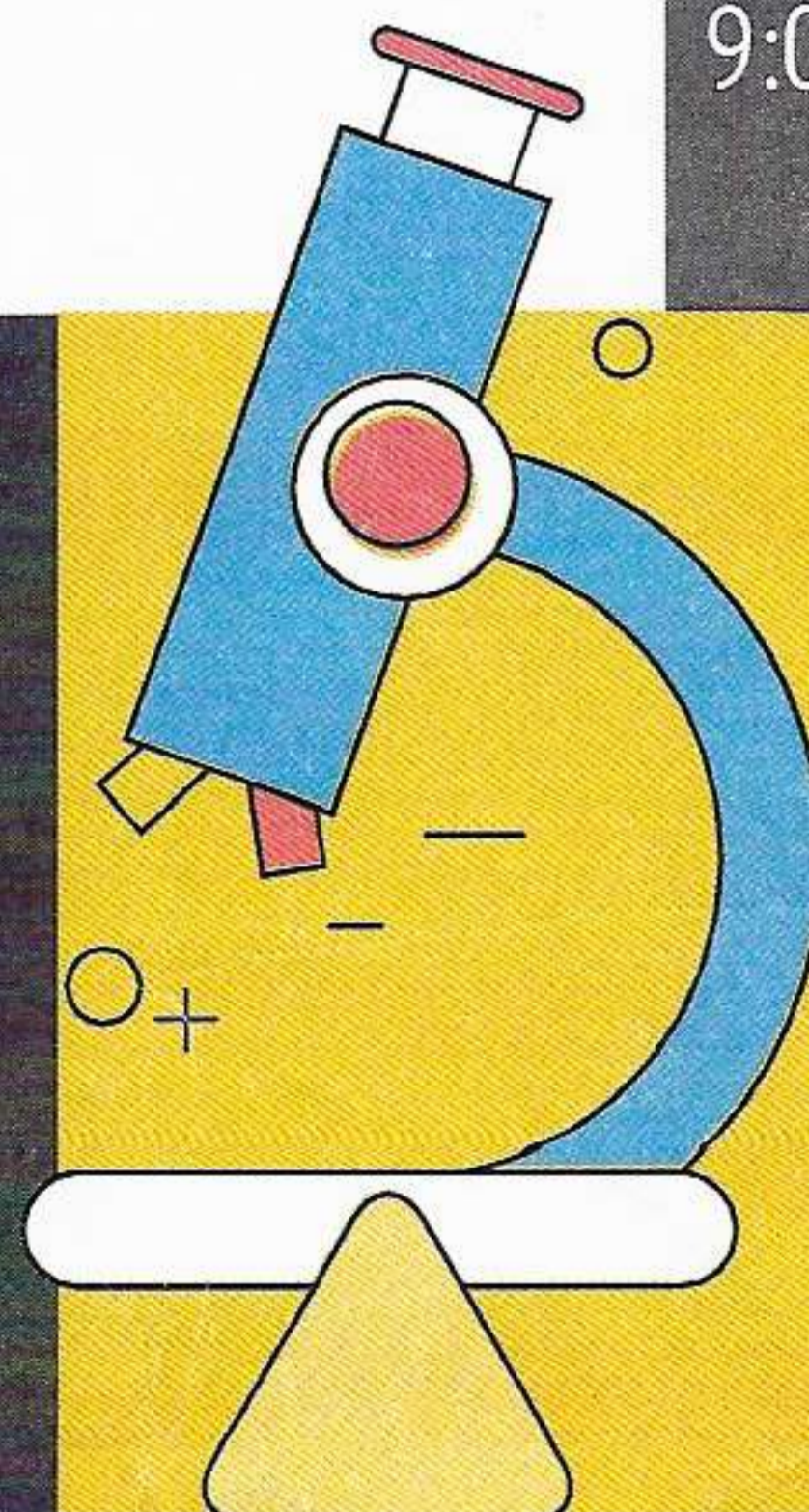
