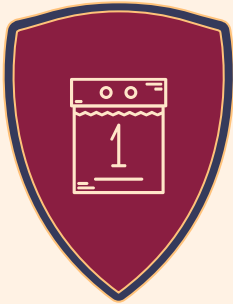

- Inaugural Cohort Class of 2022

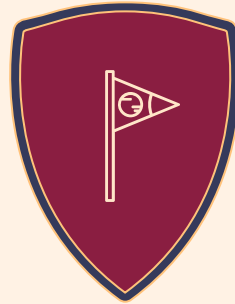


Early College at GHS

- Students are selected based on motivation



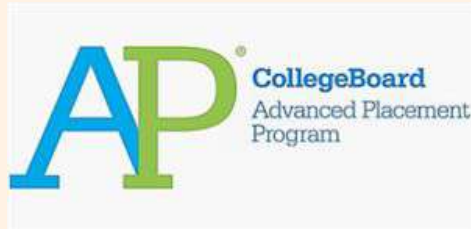
Benefits



IGETC


Earning the IGETC will become optional and not a requirement of the Early College Program
