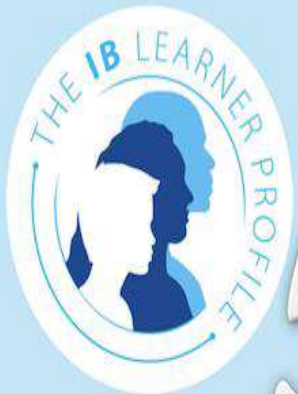
- Overview

 - Highest achievement offered in academics
 - Learn with a global perspective
- Requirements
 - Core: Theory of Knowledge, CAS, Extended Essay
 - 6 classes - 3 HL, 3 SL



Difference between AP and IB (Ethan)

AP	IB
Scored from 1-5	Scored from 1-7
College credit for 3+ (depending)	College credit for 4+ (depending)
Measured by a one day, largely multiple choice exam	Measured by multiple assessments throughout the course like labs, essays, projects, oral commentaries, and objective tests
Measures breadth of knowledge	Measures depth of knowledge
Courses stand alone	Integrated curriculum over 2 years with CAS, Extended Essay, and TOK for a well-rounded individual. Teacher communication across courses to support you
Any student may take AP exams	Only IB students enrolled in IB courses may take IB exams

- 6 IB classes - one from each subject group
 - 3 HL, 3 SL combo or 4 HL, 2 SL combo
 - 6th group can be an art class or a second science or psychology or business
- Step 1: Identify the level you are at in each subject group.
 - 1) English HL is required
 - 2) What language level are you in?
 - 3) What math level are you in?
 - 4) Chemistry in 10th grade?
- Step 2: Start to identify which courses you want as an HL and which as an SL.

College credit (Kallen, Sam)

You may get way more credit than you think!

- A score of **30 or more** = **30 college quarter credits** at UC
 - UC Berkeley, UC San Diego, UC Los Angeles, UC Santa Barbara, etc.
- Universities award college credit mostly for 5's and above (UC, State, Private)
- Students are awarded credit for SL more often if they do the full diploma
- Special consideration for admission for IB Diploma students
 - CSU Fullerton, Northern Arizona, UC schools, various private universities

MVHS Statistics



- IB students accepted to over 100 universities, such as: UC Berkeley, UCSD, NYU, BYU, SDSU, Cal Poly SLO, UCLA, USC, West Point, Texas A&M
- Every Diploma student has been accepted to a 4 year university.
- In 2017, 92% of seniors earned their IB diploma
- 30 is our school average for the diploma
- 83% pass rate across all IB exams with almost half earning a 100% pass rate
