School Day Overview

Welcome to the 2021-2022 School Year!! Thank you for choosing Ganado Primary School. It is our pleasure to have your child attend our school. The following is our Reopening Plan for our Hybrid and Online Learning, and safety procedures before, during, and after school.

Hybrid Learning (A/B Days)

BEFORE School

(Please check for any symptoms, remind your child to follow the bus rules, wear their mask at all times and social distance)

Parents/Guardian should perform Daily Health Screenings at home.

Ensure that your child/children do not exhibit any signs and symptoms as stated on the GUSD #20 Reopening Plan: Daily Health Screenings; therefore, monitor your child's symptoms before he/she boards the bus or is dropped off at school. If your child shows any symptoms please keep him/her at home.

- ◇ If your child is not sick and shows no signs of symptoms, please...
 1. Have them wear their mask at all times, this is the requirement in the school building and around campus.
 2. Encourage your child not to share their belongings at any time.
 3. Encourage your child to keep their hands, feet, and other objects to themselves at all times.

GUSD #20 Bus Reopening Plan: Enhanced Social Distancing (Bus Transportation)

Bus drivers/aides will take temperature checks when children load or if they observe a child feeling ill.

- ◇ Seating is assigned by bus driver.
- ◇ Each seating area is marked for students
- ◇ Masks are worn at all times
- ◇ Students will follow bus rules and expectations.
- ◇ There will be 2 bus runs to minimize the number of students to meet CDC guidelines.
- ◇ After each drop off, drivers sanitize the bus at the schools.

GPS Bus Drop off Site

- ◇ GPS staff will provide assistance and directions for our students
- ◇ AM bus riders will be directed to go directly to the cafeteria, since they have been screened on the bus.
- ◇ AM parent drop off will be directed to enter the northeast sidewalk for screening.
- ◇ “Any student with visible symptoms of runny nose, cough, shortness of breath, vomiting, or temperature of or above 100.4 degrees will be taken to the health office.”
- ◇ After breakfast, students are directed to their classrooms/designated areas.

Morning Walkers and Student Drop

- ◇ Due to capacity limits and for the safety of the students and staff, only one parent/guardian may accompany their child to the Front Entrance.
 - ◇ Parents are only allowed to bring their child up to the screening site, located on the east side of the Primary School.
 - ◇ Staff members will assist with the following:
 - Student Drop-off (AFTER 7:30am)
 - Temperature checks
 - Breakfast in Cafeteria
- Student(s) arriving after 8:00am, will be screened and issued a tardy pass to class by the front office.

DURING School

(Masks are worn at all times, social distancing is observed at all times, and washing hands is regularly)

Please send your child with a clean Mesh or See-through backpack. This is a district requirement.

1. Lunch in the Classroom

- ◇ Procedures
 - Lunch is picked up by students at their designated time in the cafeteria
 - Students will walk with their class to the cafeteria to pick up their lunch.
 - Our GPS teachers/assistants will monitor students during Lunch in the Classroom
 - Our GPS teachers/assistants are aware of the Lunch in the Classroom procedure.
 - Guidelines provided by food services are followed by staff.

2. Classroom

Classroom tables/desks are spaced accordingly, with sneeze guards—6ft apart

Hand Sanitizer is available

Disinfectant spray is supplied

Students will not be allowed to share food

3. Instruction in the Classroom

- Instruction in the Classroom and Allied Classes (I.e. General Education, ESS, Dine Studies, Sparks, Computer time, IR, and Library)
 - Students will have assigned seats in the classroom
 - Desks are positioned 6-ft apart for social distancing
 - Students must wear a mask at all times
 - Mounted Hand Sanitizers are available at different locations throughout the school. Students are encouraged to keep personal hand sanitizers in their backpacks.
 - Water fountains will not be used in the classrooms. Students are recommended to bring personal water bottles
 - Classroom Sinks will be used with teacher supervision.
- Students enrolled in the online platform are committed to that instruction for the first semester (1st and 2nd Quarter)

Hallways/Restrooms

Hallways

- Hand-sanitizers dispensers are mounted on the walls throughout the school building.
- Water fountains are not to be used.
 - * Students can bring clean water bottles from home but cannot be shared with peers
 - * Ensure student water bottles are labeled with student name.
 - * Students follow blue arrows on the floors to ensure foot-traffic control throughout the school building.

Restrooms

- Limited number of students in the restrooms
- Custodians and assigned staff member(s) sanitize and clean restroom on a consistent basis.
- Sinks/soap are readily available for hand washing.

Recess

- Recess time is supervised by classroom teacher/Instructional assistant
- Students must wear a mask at all times and continue social distancing.
- Students will wash/sanitize hands before and after recess.
- basketballs, footballs, and toys are not allowed for utilization at school.

Attendance

If your child is not in school on their scheduled day, you will need to report they are present daily BY 8:30am. Please inform their teacher through google classroom

OR

Submit attendance through our GPS Website, through the GUSD main website. It is titled "Daily Attendance Submission"

AFTER School

(Masks are worn at all times, social distancing is observed at all times, and washing hands is regularly)

Bus Pickup Site

(There will be no Bus Passes this year) A letter was sent home by the School Superintendent

Staff members will ensure that students are social distancing in a designated area awaiting loading at the bus loop.

Staff will escort students to the Bus Line up to board buses.


- Students will follow the Bus Rules for boarding/exiting the bus as instructed by the bus driver/bus aide(s)
- Students will continue to wear their mask and observe social distance.
- Students sanitize their hands when boarding the bus.

Your child's safety is important to us. Teachers will not release a student during or at the bus line up. Please do a request to have your child wait in gym (by 12pm), where you will pick him/her up. NO ONE is allowed to walk thru the bus line up. Students and School Staff Only.

Due to CDC guidelines and GUSD safety protocols, the number of students on bus has been limited. At this time we are discouraging bus change requests/bus passes.

Afterschool Student Pick-Up in the gym

- Arrangements for pick-up must be made in writing with the front office by 12:00 pm (Fax number is 928-755-1202, no phone call requests, please submit in writing, or email it to us. Thank you.
- Students must be picked up by 1:30 pm during the Hybrid Schedule, no late than 1:40 pm
- Due to Capacity Limits and for the safety of the students, staff, and only one parent/guardian may pick up their child at the gym at the north entrance to gym.
- Parents/Guardians must sign out their child at pick up
- Assigned staff member will assist with the following:
Student pick-up/Sign out at 1:30 pm in the gym.
