### IB and AP Courses

We are proud of our students that are choosing to take a rigorous IB or AP course as part of the 2016-2017 school year. Research proves that the extra efforts put into AP and IB courses have a direct effect on success in college.

An important part of these courses is the assessment that comes from the College Board (for AP courses) and the International Baccalaureate Organization (for IB courses). These assessments help the students see a cumulative picture of what they have learned, help the teachers guide their instruction based on specific feedback and data, and, in many cases, can earn college credit for the students.

## All students that take and AP or an IB course need to plan on taking the assessment associated with each course.

Plan ahead so that you can meet the registration and payment deadlines. The details of the costs are listed below.

Do not hesitate to ask your counselor for further clarification.

### AP exams

- Online exam registration will be open from August 1 - Sept 23, 2016.
- Register online at <u>www.totalregistration.net/ap/030045</u> after Aug 1
- Each AP exam costs \$96.
- Students on the federal Free and Reduced Lunch owe only \$20 per exam
- Tax Credit \$\$ can be used to pay for AP exams.
- Payment must be made to the CHS Bookstore by November 18, 2016.
- Financial Assistance is available. Do not let lack of funds keep you from testing. See your counselor.
- Students who do not register and complete payment will not be allowed to continue in the AP course in Semester 2.

Students who are taking the course for Dual Enrollment are given a ½ price reduction on either AP or IB exam.

### IB assessments

- Online exam registration will be open from August 1 - Sept 23, 2016.
- Register online at <u>www.totalregistration.net/ib/030045</u> after Aug 1
- \*\*For both AP and IB exams note different web site for each exam!\*\*
- IB students are recognized at graduation
- To be a registered IB student, there is a \$175
   one-time registration fee in the first testing vear.
- Each IB exam costs \$120.
- Students on the federal Free and Reduced Lunch pay \$20 per exam and \$20 reg fee
- Tax Credit \$\$ can be used to pay for IB fees.
- Payment must be made to the CHS Bookstore by November 4, 2016.
- Financial Assistance is available. Do not let lack of funds keep you from testing. See counselor.
- Students who do not register and complete payment will not be allowed to continue in the IB course in Semester 2.
