**A. To qualify for CSF membership follow these guidelines**

**1. You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last semester's grades.**

- a. The first 7 points must be from LIST I AND LIST II.
- b. The remaining points may come from any LIST I, II, or III.
- c. It is okay if all of your points come from LIST I

2. You must use **NO MORE THAN 5 CLASSES** to qualify.

3. NO CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assisting, and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.

4. CSF points are granted as follows:

A grade of A = 3 CSF points

A grade of B = 1 CSF points

**One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP or DE class up to a maximum of 2 such points per semester.**

A grade of C = 0 CSF points A grade of F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership at this time.

**B. Also remember**

1. Membership is based on work from the *previous* semester AND you must reapply **EACH** semester

2. Courses you may use are listed on the following pages. They are divided into LISTS I, II and III.
