COURSE DESCRIPTION: In this 18-week course students will explore occupational goals by use of the state of California's educational resource – California Colleges and by applying the principles of our districts 'Senior Cumulating Project'. Students will also be introduced to Microsoft Office programs and gain a basic understanding of internet safety / resources, computer terminology, keyboarding, internet searching, researching, career/college exploration and public speaking, while incorporating MYP/IB principles.

COURSE CONTENT OBJECTIVES:

This course provides the student with base knowledge for learning in the 21st century. It incorporates defining, evaluating, managing, and communicating information, media literacy, and career development skills using critical thinking, problem solving, and career readiness skills. Students will learn how to locate, use, and evaluate the necessary information, programs, and technology needed to complete a rigorous secondary education program. Students will begin to explore personal career / life goals as it pertains to the Freshman Project.

ASSIGNMENT (Late Work) **POLICY**:

Students will be reminded of missing assignment(s) via multiple resources – class, text, Haiku announcements, etc. Students are also encouraged to check ABI during class, after assignments have been returned, to verify scores and current grade.
