

Summer Schools

The Board may operate summer sessions for secondary students who need developmental, remedial or make-up work in basic skills, academic courses and vocational areas. When possible, it shall provide summer programs in reading and other basic areas for elementary students.

No tuition shall be charged for students who are residents of the district and whose need for a summer program has been identified by teachers. The Board also may authorize summer enrichment programs for which it may charge tuition. The financing of remedial and development programs shall take precedence over the latter.

All summer programs shall be subject to annual approval by the Board.

The director of the summer session shall be appointed by the Board upon recommendation of the superintendent.

Teachers for summer sessions shall be recruited from the district staff insofar as possible. The Board shall set summer salaries and make appointments.

Except as a condition of promotion, no student shall be required to enroll in the summer program. However, students who enroll shall be required to attend regularly or be dropped from the summer roll.
