

Measure GG History

In accordance with 2014-2015 Resolution No. 40, approved by the Corona-Norco Unified School District Board of Education on August 5, 2014, the Board is committed to maintaining the quality of education in local schools with safe, upgraded classrooms, libraries, science labs and technology systems to keep pace with 21st century learning standards. To that end, the Board evaluated the District's urgent and critical facility needs, including safety issues, class size, computer and information technology, enrollment trends and prepared a Master Facilities Plan in developing the scope of projects to be funded. Based on the results of this evaluation, it was determined that the Measure GG bond funds were to be equitably distributed between projects benefitting the areas of Corona, Norco and Eastvale based on each area's assessed valuation at the time the bond initiative was being prepared. As a result, Corona is to receive 63% of the bond funds, Norco 14% of the bond funds and Eastvale 23% of the bond funds. The allocation of bond proceeds used to fund projects listed on the scope of projects may be affected by the District's receipt of State matching funds and the final costs of each project. In the absence of State matching funds, which the District will aggressively pursue to reduce the District's share of the costs of the projects, the District may not be able to complete some of the projects listed. The budget for each project is an estimate and may be affected by factors beyond the District's control. The final cost of each project will be determined as plans are finalized, construction bids are awarded and projects are completed. Based on the final costs of each project, certain projects listed on the scope of projects may be delayed or may not be completed.

Proceeds from the sale of the bonds shall be used only for the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, rehabilitation, or replacement of school facilities, including the furnishing and equipping of school facilities, and not for any other purpose, including teacher and school administrator salaries and other operating expenses.







State School Facility Funding Program (SFP)

Breakdown of District SFP Funds

The Corona-Norco Unified School District has been part of the State School Facility (SFP) grant funding program for over 20 years. The receipt of State grants is predicated on: 1) the District meeting the State's eligibility requirements; 2) the State funding amounts remaining at the current 50/50 for eligible new construction and 60/40 for eligible modernization projects; and 3) the Governor issuing State School Bonds.

Since 2000, the District has obtained over \$340 million in State funding. During the past fiscal year, the District has successfully received over **\$40.3 million** in modernization and new construction funding.

Completed Measure GG modernization projects in the Corona/Unincorporated area are: Adams, Jefferson, Garretson Elementary, and Lincoln Fundamental Elementary School.

Completed Project - Washington Elementary

The Construction of Washington Elementary School was completed in Summer of 2022. The scope of the project included adding a permanent kindergarten building and modernization of the administrative offices and the playground.







Completed Project - Corona-Fundamental Intermediate

The Construction of Corona-Fundamental Intermediate School was completed in Summer of 2022. The scope of the project included a multi-purpose room/gymnasium with boys' and girls' locker rooms and an indoor outdoor stage feature to support the performing arts programs.









Projects Currently Underway - Corona High School ASB/Library

This project involves the modernization of the ASB and Library spaces to make both space more usable and efficient for students. This project is currently in the design phase. Construction is expected to start in Winter of 2022.













Projects Currently Underway - Auburndale & Raney Gyms

Both of these projects include building new gyms and removing portable classrooms. Both projects are currently in the conceptual design phase. Construction is expected to start Fall of 2023.

Projects Currently Underway – Highland Elementary School Site Improvements

This project includes replacing modular classrooms and upgrading the library and the multi-purpose room. This project is currently in the conceptual design phase.



Information Technology Upgrades

Technology updates have been part of Measure GG funding. The Measure GG technology funding is focused on infrastructure and classroom technology. The infrastructure includes data pathways, cabling, and electrical infrastructure. The classroom technology includes a complete control system that unifies the classroom digital learning environment. A total of \$60 million will be used for technology.

A total of \$37.5 million from the current Measure GG issuances has been allocated towards the above technology installs and upgrades across the District. Installation for classroom technology is continuing and scheduled to be complete by the end of 2022/23 school year. At that time, the District will start the projector classroom refresh for all devices over 7 years old. The supply chain issues are still causing delays in the completion of these projects. To date, the District has finalized installation of more than 2,400 projectors, 400 whiteboards, and over 8,300 data drops. Elementary schools received 250 interactive whiteboards. The Educational Services department continues to provide professional development for the new technology being installed in our classrooms.

Measure GG updates and videos shared on social media are included in the District's Connection Newsletter. The newsletter goes out to staff and families weekly.








