College Credit Plus

Ohio's dual enrollment opportunity for eligible students in grades 7-12



- Earn high school and college credit concurrently
- Promotes college & career readiness
- Highly transferable courses
- Accessible course offerings
 - High school (if available), Edison State campuses, Online
- Courses can satisfy high school graduation requirements



Cost to Participate

Participation is **FREE**

- No application fee
- No assessment fee
- Tuition & textbooks are included
- Consumable supplies purchased by student
- Financial risk for failed/withdrawn courses

Public School Students

- Participation is **FREE** within funding limits

Non-public & Homeschool Students

- Must apply for funding (annually)
 - Awarded amount may vary each year
- www.ohiohighered.org/ccp/students-families

Course Options

Eligible students may take up to 30 credit hours per academic year (summer, fall, spring)

- Dependent on number of non-CCP courses taken at the HS
 - $30 - (\text{secondary school units} \times 3) = \text{CH available for year}$

Course Registration Limits

- Prerequisites must be met prior to course registration
- "First 15 Rule"
 - Must complete 15 credit hours in Level I before progressing to Level II
- Course Exclusions
 - Private instruction, remedial/developmental, physical education, study abroad, courses with high fees, sectarian
- CCP probation





Course Content

CCP Courses = College Courses

- Content consistent regardless of location and enrolled student population

May include mature subject matter

- Potential for graphic, explicit, violent, or sexual nature
- Permission Slip
 - Parent & student must sign at the time of application
- Mature Content Questionnaire
 - Student completes after acceptance & before registration
 - Verify possession of necessary social & emotional maturity
 - Verify readiness to accept responsibility & independence necessary of college classroom

Review course descriptions, syllabi, & required materials online

- Academic catalog - course descriptions

Grades

Grades recorded on high school AND college transcripts

- College courses (3, 4, 5 credit hours = 1 Carnegie Unit)

Self-Pay Students

- Students opting to self-pay must select prior to reporting deadline if grade included on HS transcript

Lasting Impacts

- Permanent college record, impacts high school & college GPA, athletic eligibility, financial aid eligibility

Failing or Withdrawing

- Probation & Dismissal: state guidelines for underperforming students
- Financial Responsibility: reimbursement to high school for associated costs

How to get started...

Submit Letter of Intent

- Submit to HS by April 1st

ESCC Recommended timeline:

- New students: complete application and assessment
 - May 1st: summer & fall participation
 - November 1st: spring participation



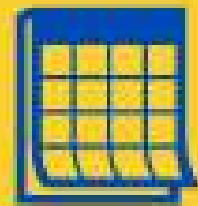

- Edison State admission
- Generates student account & ESCC ID number
- Application **MUST** be completed prior to assessment process



Establish Eligibility

In order to participate in the CCP program, students must meet specific program and course eligibility criteria.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- Statewide standards for participation
- College-level (remediation free) assessment scores
 - ACT, SAT, ACCUPLACER
- **Proposed:** 3.0 cumulative HS GPA

COURSE ELIGIBILITY

- Edison State course prerequisites
 - Satisfactory assessment scores (reading/math)
 - Multiple measures

College-Level Scores

ACCUPLACER

- 250 Reading
- 263 Math QAS or AAF

ACT

- 18 English
- 22 Reading
- 22 Math

- Schedule ACCUPLACER
- Instructions for transcript submission
- Students receive eligibility notice after assessment scores or transcripts are reviewed.

Course Registration

Mature content questionnaire must be on file prior to first semester registration.

- Complete online at www.edisonohio.edu/ccpmature

REGISTRATION OCCURS EACH SEMESTER

- Summer, Fall, & Spring

COURSES ON CAMPUS OR ONLINE

- CCP Registration Form
 - All requests require guidance counselor authorization
 - Add, Delete, Drop, Withdraw
 - Must be submitted to Edison State prior to each term
 - Timelines, waitlists, HS registration dates

COURSES AT PARTNERING HIGH SCHOOLS

- CCP Registration Form OR Batch Registration/Rosters

- Log-in credentials available after student's first course registration

Level I Courses and Non-Allowable Courses

Level I Courses

- Transferable course - OTM, TAG or CTAG courses
- Course in computer science, information technology, anatomy, physiology or foreign language including American Sign Language
- Technical certificate course
- 15-credit or 30-credit hour model pathway course
- Study skills, academic or career success course
- Internship courses

Non-Allowable Courses

- One on One instructional courses
- Courses with fees that exceed a limit set by the Chancellor
- Study abroad courses
- Physical education courses
- Pass/Fail or S/U grade courses unless an internship or transferable course
- Remedial course or Sectarian religion course

STEP 1: APPLY

- ONLINE Sinclair CCP Application Apply at: apply.Sinclair.edu/ccp



STEP 2: Determine ELIGIBILITY

- Accepted based on qualified scores OR high school GPA
- Need testing to determine college-ready eligibility



Am I Eligible For CCP?

- **Assessments at Sinclair**
- **Statewide Test Scores**
- **Must Test College Level in One Area without high school GPA**

English & Social Sciences

- An ACT score ≥ 18 in English or
SAT score ≥ 480 in English, or
 - WritePlacer ≥ 5

Math & Science

- An ACT score ≥ 22 in math or
SAT score ≥ 530 in math, or
 - ALEKS ≥ 46

Mature Content

Per state law, students must understand that a college class could expose them to mature content.

1. Both the student and their parent/guardian must acknowledge that a college class could contain graphic and mature content. **IN THE ONLINE APPLICATION**
2. Student will complete the CCP Mature Content Questionnaire before registering for classes. **ONCE ACCEPTED**

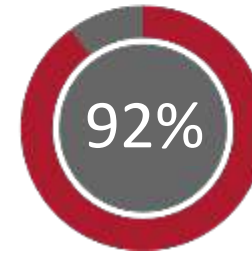

PROS AND CONS OF TAKING CCP+ COURSES

BENEFITS

- ▶ Earn college credit for free
- ▶ Take courses that you may be interested in pursuing as a major
- ▶ Courses may be taken summer prior to school year may
- ▶ Scholarships for CCP+ when continue to undergrad studies at CCP college

Things to Consider

- ▶ Is my student mature enough for college courses
- ▶ Courses taken may not transfer to college of choice following graduation
- ▶ Parents are not informed or communicated with by professors
- ▶ Self directed / independent
- ▶ IEP and 504 plans may not be followed

Athletic Eligibility

Student athletes should:

1. Learn the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA) requirements
2. Know that summer term CCP courses cannot be used to bring a student into compliance with the OHSAA requirements for interscholastic athletic participation
