

# STUDENT USE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Policy 524 contains information regarding Student Use of Information Technology. Students are able to access the Internet from every classroom. Students are expected to follow guidelines for acceptable use of the Internet and Student Code of Ethics Using Social Media.

Should parents (or students age 18 or older) **NOT** want the following technologies to be used, please schedule an appointment with the MARSS Coordinator at the District Service Center and you will be asked to complete a form. **This form must be completed annually by October 1<sup>st</sup>.**

- G-Suite and additional district approved apps
- Chromebooks
- iPad or school-issued tablet
