
# Install Google Drive File Stream G: Drive

### **General considerations**

1. Before you begin the transfer of your N:drive it would be a good idea to clean out the old files that you no longer need or want. You could sort your N:drive files and folders by date and take a look at whether you need the files you haven't used in over a year. If you don't need them, just delete them straight from the N:drive. This is entirely up to you, but it could drastically reduce the amount of files that you really need to hold on to in the transfer process.

#### **Install**

- 1. Navigate to your Google Drive account at <u>drive.google.com</u> or by clicking on the in the top toolbar of your Google account and click on Drive.
- 2. Click on the gear icon and select "Get Drive for desktop."




- Scroll down and select "Download & install Drive File Stream". Click on the **DOWNLOAD FOR** WINDOWS blue button.

- 4. Save the *googledrivefilestream.exe* to your computer. Double-click and install the downloaded *googledrivefilestream.exe* file.
- 5. Sign in to Google Drive when prompted.

#### **Access**

You can access Drive File Stream from the taskbar or inside Windows File Explorer as your G:
 Drive.





## **Transferring files from N: Drive**

- Drag and Drop File
  - Open your N: drive in one window and open your newly installed G: drive in another window. Double click My Drive from your Drive. Drag the entire N:drive folder with your name into the new G: drive and drop it in. The transfer will begin automatically and will vary in time based on the size of your N:drive.
