2021 JACK PETTEYS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Jack Petteys Memorial Scholarship is awarded annually to one outstanding male student-athlete from Brush, Ft. Morgan and Sterling High Schools. The scholarship may be used at any two or four-year accredited college or university, and is renewable for a total of four years if a minimum of a 2.5 GPA average is maintained. The amount of the scholarship is \$4,000 per year, renewable, for a total of \$8,000 at a two-year school, or \$16,000 at a four-year school.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS AND SCHOOL OFFICIALS

- 1. Scholarship applications are to be completed by the applicant and returned to the school official in charge of scholarships by <u>April 1</u>. Applications received after that day will not be considered.
- 2. An application containing <u>all</u> of the following items must be completed for a student to be considered as a candidate.
 - a. Application form completed by the student.
 - Transcript of high school courses and grades, containing SAT/ACT scores, class rank and size of graduating class. A SAT score of <u>1100</u> or ACT score of <u>22</u> is necessary to apply.
 - c. A <u>signed</u> personal letter from the applicant (one page maximum) indicating why he is applying for the scholarship and outlining his college goals and objectives for the future.
 - d. Two completed Personal Reference Forms <u>with attached signed letters</u> from qualified people <u>outside</u> the school system (e.g. doctor, minister, neighbor or employer) who know the student well.
- 3. Criteria to be considered in selecting a candidate: a boy must be in the top 25% of his class taking college preparatory classes, be a U.S. citizen, score at least 1100 on his SAT test or 22 on his ACT test, show college-level academic promise, have lettered in a sport, and have very strong qualities of leadership and character.
- 4. The winner will be notified early in May.
- 5. In case the winner receives other renewable scholarships totaling more than \$2,000 from sources other than his college, he must choose either the Jack Petteys Scholarship or any other(s). One-time grants do not count toward the \$2,000 figure. While the amount of scholarship monies received from the student's college is not restricted, the total amount of scholarship monies cannot exceed the cost of tuition, fees, room and board as verified by the college.
- 6. If a winner chooses not to accept the scholarship, it will be awarded to the next qualified candidate.
