1. Session Title: Formative Assessment: assessment practices to meet students where they are.

Session Description: We will work through the when, how and why of formative assessment, and walk away with something you can use the very next day in your

classrooms. Formative assessment can look different in each discipline, but when used with purpose (for learning) it can transform student engagement and student outcomes in your classroom.

The following is an excerpt from A repair Kit for Grading, Ken O'Connor, 2007, p. 97. "Their research and the work of others have shown that improving formative assessment and using assessment for learning raises the achievement of all students, but it has the most significant impact on low achievers. Learning gains made through using assessment for learning are similar to those achieved through one-on-one coaching."
