

Applications for Maloney and Rotella Interdistrict Magnet Schools, Pre-Kindergarten-Grade 5 students will be available February 3, 2020 through February 28, 2020 online only. You may submit an online application for the two (2) Waterbury Elementary Magnet Schools by going on the link https://waterbury.novuschoice.com. If you do not have access to a computer, please feel free to utilize the parent computers at each school, and someone will assist you to complete your application.

Citywide lottery will be held on March 9, 2020, at Rotella Interdistrict Magnet School. Lottery numbers will not be issued at this time. Applicants will be notified via mail.

Please note that to apply to Pre-Kindergarten for both schools, your child must have been born in the year 2016. There is **no** transportation provided to Waterbury Pre-Kindergarten students.
