Beginning 1/1/23 through 6/30/24 all students qualifying as eligible for reduced priced meals now qualify for free meals thanks to the Reduced Priced meal subsidy approved by the AZ Dept. of Education.

Policy reminders: if a student is absent from school, he or she may not attend any after school extracurricular activity on that day. This includes music, drama, clubs, athletic events, practices and/or dances. Students in grades 1 through 8 arriving at school between 9:38 am & 11:30 am are considered absent for half a day. Students in grades 1—8 arriving after 11:31 are considered absent for a full day.
