Reading: Wonders Unit 6 Week 2

We will be learning that there is more than one way to show a number. We will be showing this in addition sentences by joining parts to make a whole. For example, $4=2+2$ and $4=3+1$

Important Information

One important power standard in Kindergarten is to read the 50 Kindergarten Fry sight words. We work on learning these words during whole group and small group instruction and independent practice. Your time at home practicing is also crucial for your child to learn the words automatically. At this time, we have taught 31 sight words. If your family has not made flashcards with these 50 words, please take time to do so. If you need index cards, we would be happy to send some home. Just let your teacher know. Look at the Fry Sight word sheet in your child's Practice Folder to help you make these flashcards. Daily practice with all the flashcards will help your child learn the words well enough to read them easily in beginning reader texts. Thank you for making this a priority at home.
