

Student Travel

The Board believes that purposeful, well-organized and properly supervised travel experiences enable students to discover new worlds, stimulate interest in further learning, increase cultural awareness, bring historical events to life, provide first-hand experiences with scientific and environmental topics, develop self-assurance, enhance language skills and solidify an appreciation of the American way of life. The purpose of this policy is to enable individuals to establish educationally sound student travel experiences that are directly associated with specific instructional programs.

Specific guidelines and administrative procedures shall be developed in order to screen, approve, and evaluate student travel. Such procedures also shall serve to ensure that reasonable steps are taken for the safety of the participants, as well as to establish the highest educational value possible.
