Reports to:	Director of Curriculum and Instruction
Job Description:	Qualified and knowledgeable World Language French Teacher. Ability to teach French at secondary levels I-IV. Experience and/or willingness to teach AP French is also preferred.
Job Goal:	To help students learn subject matter and skills that will contribute to their development as mature, able, and responsible members of society.

Performance Responsibilities:

- ❖ Determines individual and class needs, establishes objectives and plans learning experiences.
- ❖ Implements activities using a variety of techniques that optimizes instructional time and meet objectives.
- ❖ Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior to achieve a nurturing learning atmosphere.
- ❖ Employs language/s to be taught in the classroom as the primary mode of communication, even in first-year classes
- ❖ Exhibits positive human relation skills and communicates with parents/guardians, colleagues, and community groups.
- ❖ Utilizes and communicates with internal technology such as, e-mail, web content/ document management systems, grade reporting, etc.
- ❖ Evaluates the educational program and/or student progress and maintains and submits records and reports.
- ❖ Demonstrates superior oral and written communication.
- ❖ Works with all other instructors to facilitate flexible test dates and class attendance to benefit students.
- ❖ Adheres to school system rules, administrative procedures, local board, state and federal rules and regulations.
- ❖ Engages in personal professional growth and demonstrates professional ethics and leadership.
- ❖ Attends and provides adult leadership and support for school performances and other school and student functions. (e.g. specialty productions, concerts, student retreats, school dances, student council, prom, graduation, audition interviews, etc.)

- ❖ Substantial, extended cultural immersion relative to the language/s to be taught (e.g. having been educated in, worked/lived in a country which employs the language/s to be taught)
- ❖ Professional, active memberships in organizations related to foreign language
- ❖ Experience getting students involved in experiences outside of the classroom that relate to world languages
- ❖ Alabama Teacher's Certificate (not required)
- ❖ Such alternatives to the above qualifications as the Executive Director may find appropriate and acceptable.
