#### Fourth Grade



Last Friday afternoon we had our visit with the birds of prey from Horizon Wings. This is a student and staff favorite as we get a close look at raptors like a bald eagle, a peregrine falcon and an Eastern screech owl to learn how they are adapted to survive in their habitats. We are wrapping up our study of decimals in math, the Southwest Region in Social Studies and Plant & Animal Adaptations in Science. In LA students have read about their expert group animals and will write an informational piece to show how much they have learned about animal defense mechanisms. Fifth grade students are getting very excited about the end of the school year, although more than a few have expressed to teachers that they are going to miss TIS. The teachers, of course, are going to miss them as well, but we are sure they will do a great job at the middle school.

To prepare for the middle school each class has been visited by the TMS guidance counselor Jan Bouley. She does a complete lesson on what to expect at the middle school as far as classes, teachers, and schedule. The 5th graders have also taken a field trip to the middle school to get an idea of the layout for the 6th grade classes as well as the gym, cafeteria, and other important areas. They were able to visit a 6th grade classroom where the 6th graders gave them some advice and our 5th graders were able to ask questions that were on their mind. Before they do leave, however, we still have lots of fun events to experience including Field Day, a trip to Star Hill, putting their handprints on the wall, and of course the Promotion Ceremony on the last day of school.

# REMINDER Physical Education Day Friday June 12, 2015

Dear Parents,

Physical Education Day is Friday, June 12th!!! Please help your child prepare for the day in the following ways:

<u>BREAKFAST</u>: Please make sure your child has a healthy breakfast to prepare for a day packed with a variety of physical activities.

<u>SAFETY</u>: Please apply sunscreen and bug spray to your child BEFORE they leave for school. Bug spray and sunscreen will not be allowed to be applied at school. Please wear sneakers to avoid injuries. <u>EACH CHILD SHOULD BRING TWO WATER BOTTLES!</u> Hydration is so important!!

<u>MEDICATIONS</u>: Children that visit the nurse during the school day will remain on the same schedule. If your child takes an inhaler prior to Physical Education class on a regular basis, please have him/her take their inhaler BEFORE he/she leaves for school in the morning.



## News from the Cafeteria



#### End of Year Student Account Balances

The Point of Sale System is set up as an opportunity to pre-pay for your child's meals. It is *debit*, *not a credit* system. On occasion, your student may forget their money and we have allowed them to occasionally charge a meal. As the end of the year approaches it is imperative that you pay your student's negative balance.

Starting June 1 we will not allow charging for the rest of the year. If your child does not have money in hand or their account they will receive an alternate meal of either a peanut butter or cheese sandwich, and a milk at BG and TIS.

At TMS they will receive a granola bar.

If your students has a negative balance they have been told repeatedly and/or you have already been contacted. If you would like to check the balance online and/or make a payment please sign up for "my school account" (where you can sign up for low balance notifications even if you do **not** use it to make payments). # **Summer Band Lessons!!!!**




